TAMIL NADU

New Assembly Constituencies

- The Election Commission has announced the new assembly constituencies in the bifurcated and trifurcated districts of Kancheepuram, Vellore, Villupuram and Tirunelveli
- Accordingly, **Chengalpet** would get seven segments, including sholinganallur, Pallavaram, Tambaram, Chengalpet, Tiruporur, Cheyyur (SC) and Madurantakam (SC)
- However, Alandur, Sirperumbudur (SC), Uthiramerur and Kancheepuram would continue to remain in **Kancheepuram** district
- The trifurcated **Vellore** would get Katpadi, Vellore, Anaikattu, Kilvaithinakuppam (SC) and Gudiyatham (SC) constituencies
- The newly constituted **Ranipe**t would get Arakkonam (SC), Sholingur, Ranipet and Arcot segments
- Further, **Tirupattur** will have Vaniyambadi, Ambur, Jolarpet and Tirupattur constituencies
- Mayiladuthurai carved out of Nagapattinam was not included in the redrawing exercise, since the district is still governed by a special officer and not by a district collector
- The newly Created **Kallakurichi** district gets Ulundurpet, Rishivandiyam, Sankarapuram, Kallakurichi (SC) segments
- Further, Tirunelveli, Ambasamudram, Palayamkottai, Nanguneri and Radhapuram remain in Tirunelveli district
- Sankarankoil (SC), Vasudevanallur (SC), Kadayanallur, Tenkasi and Alangulam form part of newly created **Tenkasi** district.

One Nation, One Ration Card

- Tamil Nadu government is set to launch the Centre's scheme on October 1.
- The Scheme will be implemented initially in 32 districts. It will be launched in the other six districts Madurai, Ramanathapuram, Thanjavur, Thoothukudi, Tiruvannamalai and Virudhunagar.
- The intra-state portability would facilitate more than 2 crore ration cardholders within the state to get the entitled food grains from any PDS outlet under the National Food Security Act, 2013.

- Over 25 States have already joined the scheme
- It aims to provide rations for migrant families, irrespective of their state of origin.
- All shops in the network that have point-of-sale (POS) devices will keep track of the beneficiary's withdrawals of monthly entitlements.

Solid Waste Management

- By private entity **Urbaser-Sumeet**
- Cleaning the streets, collecting waste from houses, segregating solid waste and depositing the waste in dumpyards
- Company will manage seven corporation zones and carry out 100% source segregation.

The Best District

• The Centre - has selected **Tirunelveli** as the 'Best District' in the country in terms of implementing the government's scheme for the construction of individual toilets in houses, Under the Swachh Bharat Mission, individual household toilets and integrated sanitary complexes are being built with the government's assistance.

Nano - sat

- National Aeronautics and Space Administration to launch an experimental satellite developed by three students of **Karur** in sub-orbital space next year.
- The three students, M. Adnaan of Thanthonrimalai, M. Kesavan of Nagampalli village near Malaikovilur and V. Arun of Thennilai have designed the satellite after two years of research and development.
- The Satellite, called' Indian Sat', will be launched into the sub orbit in June next on NASA's sounding rocket7

Badagas in United Nation

• The badagas, the largest indigenous community in the Nilgiris - has been included in the database of world's indigenous people, badagas are described as traditionally buffalo herders, who are nowadays turning to farming with special focus on organic farming.

• "Badaga language is part of the Dravidian language family and one of world's primary language families spoken by more than 200 million people in south, central and north India," as said by the UN.

Census of the Tiger Population using camera traps

- It was conducted in the Pollachi forest division of the Anamalai Tiger Reserve (ATR)
- A total of 245 pairs of cameras used for 25 days for the estimation in the Ulandy, Pollachi, Valparai and Manombolly forest ranges.

Archaeological Survey of India / Tiruchi

- A new administrative circle of the Archaeological Survey of India came into existence in Tiruchi
- It will have 162 monuments and sites under its control having jurisdiction over 20 central and southern districts
- The Tiruchi Circle was created by bifurcating the ASI's Chennai Circle
- It is one of the seven new circles of the ASI created across the country to improve management of monuments by the Union Ministry of Culture.

Cauvery - vaigai - Guntar river linking project

- The scheme proposes a new link canal for 250km to carry surplus waters of the Cauvery from the Mayanur barrage in Karur district to Agniyaru, South Vellar, Manimutharu, the Vaigai and Gundar under the intra State river linking programme
- The project would benefit the district of Pudukottai

<u> 'Senganthal Poonga' - Chennai</u>

- The Rs.5 crore new garden, named after Tamil Nadu's official flower Senganthal (Gloriosa superba), will have only native species of trees, flowering trees and shrubs.
- This new park will have at least 350-400 species of flowers, while Semmozhi Poonga has as many as 500 species of plants, including exotic ones

The School Education Department

• It has reduced the upper age limit for direct recruitment of teachers from 57 years to 40 years for open category and from 57 years to 45 years for reserved categories

Yaadhum Oorae - Global Virtual Conclave

- Hosted by Southern India Chamber of Commerce and Industry (SICCI) and Tamil Nadu.
- The conclave is aimed at helping the global Tamil diaspora to reconnect with the state by communicating the uniqueness of Tamil and the ethnicity of the Dravidian culture

Guidance & WEF to Setup India's & South Asia's 1st Advanced Manufacturing Hub

• Guidance, a nodal investment promotion and facilitation agency of Tamil Nadu (TN) located in Chennai has joined hands with the World Economic Forum (WEF) in set up India's and South Asia's first advanced manufacturing hub (AMHUB) in Tamil Nadu. This collaboration is in line with the Tamil Nadu Electronics Hardware Manufacturing Policy 2020

Tamil Nadu Electronics Hardware Manufacturing policy 2020:

- Tamil Nadu released its Electronics Hardware Manufacturing Policy 2020 to facilitate foreign investment in electronic systems design and manufacturing (ESDM) for the growth of indigenous startups.
- The state's focus is to raise its manufacturing output to US\$100 billion by 2025 accounting 25% of India's total electronics

Recent Related News

- During virtual Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) 'Connect 2020' event with this, it became the first state in the country to release policies on Ethical AI, Blockchain and Cybersecurity
- CM unveiled infrastructure at the Duth-era cemetery in Nagapattinam district, at the Manora Fort near Pattukottai in Thanjavur district and at the Kattabomman Fort in Panchalankurichi in Ottapidaram Taluk of Thoothukudi district.

Undertake archaeological excavation at Kinnimangalam':

Tamil-Brahmi inscription found at the site dates boack to around the 3rd century:

- Tamil Brahmi inscriptions were found in several rock paintings and pot shreds in Tamil Nadu.
- The earliest inscription found at the site was a Tamil-Brahmi in scription, dating back to around the 3rd century and 2nd century BCE, found on a broken pillar at the mutt.
- The inscription read "Egan Aadhan Kottam". Another vattezhuthu inscription, belonging to 7th or 8th century CE was also found. This was the inscription which had the word 'pallipadai' (sepulchral shrine). Another in scription belonging to the 18th century was also found.

Chola royal charter

- A royal charter or sasana of the Chola Kings, lost 300 years ago from Tamil Nadu, is now being preserved in the Leiden University in the Netherlands. Commonly referred to as the "Leiden Plates", it was issued by the kings to a Buddhist Vihara.
- The charter has two sections-one in Sanskrit and another in Tamil- and the 21 copper plates are held together by a massive bronze ring bearing the regal seal of Rajendra Chola. They also deal with the geneology of the Chola dynasty and the reign of king Rajaraja I (985-1012 AD), the father of Rajendra Chola (1012-1042 AD). It proclaims that 26 villages bordering Anaimangalam were donated for a Buddhist shrine (vihara), known as Chulamanivarmavihara, built by the Malay king of Sriwijaya in Nagapattinam, said S. Vijay Kumar, art enthusiast and co-founder of the India pride project. The Provenance states that the copper plates were donated in 1862, by successors, to the estate of professor Hendrik Arent Hamaker.
- Netherlands asked Dutch museums to return artefacts stolen by colonists to countries such as Sri Lanka and Indonesia.
- "The copper plates are an important evidence on the history of the Chola Period", retired archaeological officer C. Santhalingam said.

STATE

"Dalle khursani" Earns GI Tag

- North Eastern Regional Agricultural Marketing Corporation Limited (NERAMAC) on behalf of **Sikkim**, the red cherry pepper chilli of Sikkim, "Dalle Khursani" earned the geographical indication (GI) tag from the Union Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT).
- It is considered as one of the hottest chilli in the world with medicinal values.
- Grown in Sikkim and regions of Darjeeling, Dalle Khursani belongs to the Capsicum family and is known to be amongst the most extreme in terms of heat.

First 100% Solar - Powered Airport

• AAI achieved a major feat on October 2, 2020, by converting the Union Territory of Puducherry's airport into its first entirely solar-powered airport in the country i.e. "absolutely power-neutral" airport with the commissioning of 500KWp(kilowatts peak) ground-mounted solar power plant at a cost of Rs 2.8 crore

'Har Ghar Jal' under the Centre's ambitious Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)

- Bihar is set to become the first state among 'BIMARU'(Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh) grouping to achieve the target of 'Har Ghar Jal' under the Centre's ambitious Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)
- The Jal Jeevan mission aims to cover the country's over 19 crore rural households by 2024.

"My Town My Pride" - Jammu & kashmir

- Manoj Sinha, Lieutenant Governor (LG) of Jammu and Kashmir (J&K) announced the "My Town My Pride" programme to deliver services governance at doorsteps to the people in urban areas.
- Objective of "My Town My Pride"
- The programme is initiated with 3 main objectives,
- To enable Public outreach in towns
- To Strengthen democracy at grassroot level.
- To deliver the service at doorsteps

'Mission Shakti' - Uttar Pradesh

- Uttar Pradesh government launched a new women empowerment programme 'Mission Shakti'
- The initiative was launched in order to raise awareness and tackle crime against women in the state

<u>Punjab</u> - became the first state in the country to pass bills rejecting the centre's contentious three farm laws

• Punjab assembly unanimously passed three agriculture bills to amend the three laws and negate the Union legislation

"Tarang Suposhit Maharashtracha"

 Maharashtra's Women & Child Welfare Department launched digital platform "Tarang Suposhit Maharashtracha" to provide nutritional requirements of mother & children

Amendments in Postal Ballot System

The exception to the following-mentioned category of voters is provided under Section 60 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951.

Following voters are allowed to cast their votes through postal ballot:

Voters on election duty,

Voters above 80 years of age or Persons with Disabilities (PwD),

Voters under preventive detention.

Service voters (armed forces, the armed police force of a state and government servants posted abroad)

'India One'

- Boeing 747s of Air India have been used to fly dignitaries across the world under the name of 'AI One'.
- They will now be replaced by the two B777s
- The Boeing 777, with state-of-the-art communication and defence systems
- The new VVIP plane is likely to be named as 'India One'
- India One will be the most modern and sophisticated VVIP aircraft in the world.
- They can fly from Delhi nonstop to almost any place on earth, unlike the earlier Jumbos that need a stopover in Europe while flying between India and the Americas.

<u>Indo - Dutch MoU</u>

- India is committed to reduce carbon emissions' intensity by 33%–35% by 2030 and for this nation is collaborating internationally to achieve the ambitious sustainable targets.
- It was signed by NITI Aayog Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Amitabh Kant and Ambassador of the Netherlands to **India Marten van den Berg.**
- Notably, India is expertised in deploying high-tech solutions in a cost-effective manner, while the Netherlands is proficient in low carbon technologies.
- Decarbonization refers to the reduction or elimination of carbon dioxide from energy sources.

The ICMR-National Institute of Nutrition (NIN)

- It has redefined the ideal or reference Indian adult man and woman with regard to age to 19-39 years instead of 20-39 years.
- The body weight has been fixed at 65 kg for men and 55 kg for women as against 60 kg and 50 kg earlier respectively
- This is based on the latest national representative data available with the National Family Health Survey-4 (NFHS-4, 2015-16), National Nutrition Monitoring Bureau (NNMB, 2015-16), the World Health Organisation (WHO, 2006-07) and the Indian Academy of Paediatrics (IAP 2015).
- The 'Recommended Dietary Allowances' (RDA) is the daily dietary nutrient intake levels which would be sufficient to meet the nutrient requirements of nearly all healthy individuals.

Google India - campaign "Make Small Strong"

- The campaign was launched in order to help support small and local businesses and to boost demand for them through customer participation.
- The new digital initiative is based on feedback from Small and Medium sized Businesses (SMBs).
- It was announced by Google in collaboration with Jagran Prakashan Limited.

"Ganga Avlokan"

- The Prime Minister Narendra Modi dedicated the country's first museum on Ganga named "Ganga Avlokan
- Prime Minister also inaugurated six 'Namami Gange' projects mostly relating to the sewage treatment in Uttarakhand
- The Prime Minister had also launched a book "Rowing down the Ganges" on the occasion
- It has been co-published by National Mission for Clean Ganga and Wildlife Institute of India
- The Prime Minister also released a logo of Jal Jeevan Mission, 'Margdarshika' operating guidelines for Gram Panchayats and Paani Samitis to implement Jal Jeevan Mission, during the occasion.

CSIR Technologies for Rural Development

- Unnat Bharat Abhyan programme was launched of Education.
- It is a joint initiative of IIT-Delhi, CSIR, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan and Vijnana Bharti (VIBHA).
- The initiative was launched on the occasion of 40th foundation day of CSIR-National Institute of Science, Technology and Development Studies (NISTAD)

International Webinar on Textile tradition - India

- Weavers from 12 Countries (Indonesia, Vietnam, Bangladesh, Tajikistan, Bhutan, Bahrain, Republic of Korea, Thailand, Afghanistan, Belarus, Sri Lanka and Uzbekistan) participated in the webinar.
- It provided a platform to textile artists, artisans, weavers and craftsmen to interact, share their textile traditions.
- The Textile Sector will be vital for building an Atmanirbhar Bharat (Self-reliant India).

National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG)

- On the occasion of Gangetic Dolphin Day on October 5, National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG) launched the 'Dolphin Jalaj Safari' at six locations in the country
- The six locations are Haiderpur Wetland in Ganga in Bijnor, Brijghat, Prayagraj and Varanasi in Uttar Pradesh, Kahalgaon (Bihar) and Bandel (West Bengal).
- The move was aimed at preserving Ganga ecology as well as promoting tourism in the region
- The 'Ganga Praharis' trained volunteers from among the local community working for cleanliness of Ganga will take tourists at these sites on boat rides to view dolphins in the Ganga.
- Besides, a new campaign, 'My Ganga My Dolphin', was also launched on the occasion to conduct a dolphin census in a 250 km stretch from Bijnor to Narora.

Coalition for Epidemic Preparedness Innovations (CEPI)

• An Indian laboratory – has been chosen for the global vaccine test network by the Coalition for Epidemic Preparedness Innovations (CEPI)

- The Translational Health Science and Technology Institute (THSTI) has been chosen as one of the global network of laboratories for centralised assessment of COVID-19 vaccines.
- The THSTI is an autonomous institute of the Department of Biotechnology (DBT)
- The CEPI network will involve six labs.

India's 1st 5 "Animal Bridges"

- As a part of improving road infrastructure, there are many ongoing expressway (e-way) projects in the country including the longest Delhi-Mumbai Greenfield expressway which is to be completed by 2024.
- Among one of the features, Delhi-Mumbai expressway will have India's first five animal overpass or "animal bridges" with a combined length of over 2.5 km for safe passage of wildlife.
- These bridges are inspired from the Wildlife crossings in the Netherlands
- These will ensure no disturbance and no chance of any conflict to the Ranthambore Wildlife Corridor connecting Ranthambhore and Mukundra (Darrah) wildlife sanctuaries in Rajasthan as the wild animals will get such passage at every 500 metres interval

PM SVANIDHI

- In June 2020, the Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs (MoHUA) launched Prime Minister Street Vendor's AtmaNibhar Nidhi (PM SVANidhi) Scheme for those street vendors who had been vending on or before 24 March, 2020 by providing affordable working capital loan of up to Rs. 10,000 to resume their livelihoods after lockdown.
- For the further empowerment of street vendors under PM SVANidhi, on October 5, 2020, MoHUA has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with Swiggy, a food ordering and delivery platform in India, to onboard street food vendors on its ecommerce platform, a first of its kind initiative. This will provide online access to thousands of consumers and help these vendors grow their businesses across cities.
 - On pilot basis, this program will be initiated by taking 250 street vendors from five cities viz, Ahmadabad (Gujarat), Chennai (Tamil Nadu), Delhi, Indore (Madhya Pradesh), and Varanasi

<u>India – has recorded a 6 % decline in emission of hazardous Sulphur dioxide</u> (SO2) in 2019 Compared to 2018

- This is the first steep decline of SO2 emissions reported in the country during the last four years.
- However, India continues to be at the top in the list of big emitters for the fifth year in a row.

Kasturi Cotton India

- Smriti Zubin Irani launched First-Ever Brand & Logo for Indian Cotton through virtual mode on occasion of World Cotton Day on October 7, 2020
- India's Premium Cotton is set to be known as 'Kasturi Cotton' in World Cotton Trade.
- It will represent Whiteness, Brightness, Softness, Purity, Luster, Uniqueness and Indianness
- Cotton is one of the principal commercial crops of India and provides livelihood to 6 Million Tons of Cotton (23% of World Cotton).
- India produces 51% of the total organic cotton production in the world. "Cott-Ally"
- A Mobile Application "Cott-Ally" has been developed by Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) to provide news about weather conditions, Crop situation and Farm practices.

Nechiphu Tunnel in Arunachal Pradesh

- Rajnath Singh, Union Defence Minister virtually inaugurated 44 bridges, built by Border Roads Organisation (BRO) across 7 States/UTs(Union Territories) in border areas.
- He laid the Foundation Stone for 450 meters long, 'Nechiphu Tunnel', a bi-lane tunnel, on the road to Tawang in Arunachal Pradesh.

'Kerala Karshaka Kshemanidhi Board

- Kerala Government has formed 'Kerala Karshaka Kshemanidhi Board' (Kerala Farmers Welfare Fund Board) a Board for upliftment of Farmers in the State. It is the first time in India that a Welfare Fund Board has been formed for upliftment of farmers.
- The benefits provided to the Board Members will include personal pension, family pension, sickness benefit, disability benefit, medical assistance,

marriage and maternity allowance, education assistance and posthumous benefits. The benefit will be extended for marriage of women members and daughters of members of Welfare Fund.

NITI Aayog Announced Governing Structure of India Energy Modelling Forum (IEMF)

- NITI (National Institution for Transforming India) Aayog and United States Agency for International Development (USAID) jointly launched the India Energy Modelling Forum (IEMF) under the US-India Strategic Energy Partnership (SEP).
- IEMF aims to engage Indian researchers, knowledge partners, think tanks and national and international government agencies and departments for longterm energy planning.

World Bank aided project 'STARS' for improving school education.

- The Strengthening Teaching-Learning and Results for States or STARS scheme, will in sync with the National Education Policy 2020 and focuses on "quality based learning outcomes".
- The implementation of the STARS project will be with financial support of the World Bank amounting to \$500 million (approximately Rs 3,700 crore).

"Kamadhenu Deepawali Abhiyan"

- This initiative is being implemented by the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying.
- The campaign aims to promote the extensive use of cow dung during the Diwali season.
- This will generate more business opportunities for the cow based entrepreneurs and farmers

eSanjeevani telemedicine initiative

• The eSanjeevani telemedicine initiative of the Union Health Ministry - recently completed a record 5 lakh teleconsultations

• The top 3 states with highest teleconsultations are Tamil Nadu (1,69,977) Uttar Pradesh (1,34,992) and Himachal Pradesh (39,326).

"Tech For Tribals"

- TRIFED, Ministry of Tribal Affairs has e-launched a new initiative "Tech For Tribals" in association with Chhattisgarh MFP Federation and IIT Kanpur.
- It focuses on entrepreneurship development, soft skills, IT and business development of the tribals.

Rs.100 Coin to Honour Rajmata Vijayaraje Scindia

• Prime Minister(PM) Narendra Modi released the new coin of Rs.100 denominations to honour the legacy of Rajmata Vijayaraje Scindia on the occasion of her birth centenary over a virtual event.

75th Anniversary of FAO

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi will release a commemorative coin of Rs. 75 denomination on the occasion of 75th Anniversary of FAO On October 16, 2020
- The event will mark the long-standing relation of India with Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO).

- China to Send World's 1st Mining Robot, 'Asteroid Mining Robot' into Space by November 2020: IEEE Spectrum report
 - **Origin Space**, the Beijing-based company is set to send world's first mining robot named 'asteroid mining robot' into space by November 2020 to identify and extract resources.. The 30-gram spacecraft, **NEO-1**, is likely to be launched as a secondary payload on a **Chinese Long March rocket**.
- This company also has another mission, **Yuanwang-1** ('Look up-1'), nicknamed '**Little Hubble'**, which is to be launched by late 2021 or early 2022.

Prakash Javadekar Addressed UN Summit on Biodiversity

- On September 30, 2020, Union minister Prakash Keshav Javadekar addressed the UN Summit on Biodiversity, which was convened by the President of the General Assembly, Volkan Bozkir, under the theme of "Urgent action on biodiversity for sustainable development".
- The summit is first of its kind ever taken place on Biodiversity in the United Nations General Assembly. We are approaching the end of the UN Decade on Biodiversity 2011-2020 so, there is an urgent need to accelerate action to conserve biodiversity
- India has added around 3 million hectares of forest and tree cover, which has enhanced the combined forest and tree cover to 24.56% of the total geographical area of the country.
- India aims to restore 26 million hectares of degraded and deforested land and achieve land-degradation neutrality by 2030.
- India has also set additional targets of eliminating single-use plastic by 2022 and installing 450 GW of renewable energy by 2030.
- The post-2020 global biodiversity framework that will be adopted at the 15th Conference of Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) in 2021 provides a good opportunity to enhance efforts to conserve and protect nature.
- India has organized two Conference of Parties (CoPs) for conserving biodiversity viz. CoP 14 of UNCCD (United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification) during September 2019 in New Delhi, and CoP 13 of the Convention on Migratory Species (CMS) in Gandhinagar, Gujarat during February 2020

'India PV EDGE 2020'

- The summit is being organized to ramp up the efforts on promoting cuttingedge solar cell manufacturing in India.
- The Indian government had initially targeted for 20 GW capacity by 2022, which was achieved four years ahead of schedule.
- The target was again modified to 450 GW of renewable capacity by 2030 comprising solar energy target of 300 GW
- For achieving the target, India has established 42 solar parks.
- India has now become the third-largest solar capacity country in the world
- India also proposed and set up the International Solar Alliance (ISA) with its headquarter at Gurugram, Haryana.
- Further, India has also launched the "One Sun One World one Grid" concept and "World Solar Bank" in order to harness the solar power globally.

<u>Virtual Vaishvik Bhartiya Vaigyanik (VAIBHAV)</u>

India, Chile hold First Joint Commission Meeting

Joint Anti Terrorist Exercise 'Suraksha Kavach'

• A joint anti-terrorist exercise "Suraksha Kawach (security shield)" between Indian Army and Maharashtra Police at Lullanagar Pune (Maharashtra

• "INS Sindhuvir"

• The Myanmar Navy is all set to receive its first submarine namely "Indian Naval Ship (INS) Sindhuvir", a Kilo class submarine which will be handed over by India under its vision of SAGAR (Security And Growth for All in the Region) to provide guaranteed security for all maritime partners.

BrahMos supersonic cruise missil

- The new BrahMos missile was test-fired from a land-based mobile launcher.
- It has the capability to strike targets over 400km away with pin-point accuracy. This was the third test of the extended range land-attack BrahMos cruise missile
- The original 290-km range BrahMos, jointly developed with Russia, has already been deployed in Ladakh as well as Arunachal Pradesh during the ongoing military confrontation with China.
- The armed forces over the last decade have inducted land and warship-based versions of the air-breathing BrahMos missiles
- These missiles fly almost three times the speed of sound at Mach 2.8.
- The first squadron of Sukhoi-30MKIs armed with BrahMos missiles was commissioned at Thanjavur in Tamil Nadu in January this year.
- BrahMos was developed jointly by Defence Research Development Organization (DRDO) and the Federal State Unitary Enterprise NPO Mashinostroyenia (NPOM) of Russia.
- It has been named after the rivers Brahmaputra and Moskva.
- BrahMos is a ramjet supersonic cruise missile which can be launched from submarines, land, ships or fighter jets.
- The range of Brahmos missile has been increased to 450-600 km in compliance with the Missile Technology Control Regime (MTCR).

DISC- Defence India Startup Challenge

• To promote the participation of frontline members of defence in indigenous innovation, on September 29, 2020,

• **iDEX4Fauji** was launched, a first of its kind initiative allowing Faujis (Soldiers) or members of the Indian Armed Forces to become part of this process and get recognised.

Kanaklata Barua

- The Indian Coast guard Vessel, Kanaklata Barua was commissioned at Kolkata recently through video conferencing
- The ICGS Kanaklata Barua is one among the five Fast Patrol Vessels (FPVs)
- It has been built by Kolkata based Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE).

Gallants of Galwan

- The Indian Army has built a memorial in the honour of twenty soldiers who lost their lives in the Galwan Clash between Indian Army and Chinese Army on June 15, 2020
- It contains the names of the martyred soldiers and they have been mentioned as "Gallants of Galwan".

Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO)

- Tested a new weapon for anti-submarine warfare that involves a supersonic missile assisted release of torpedo (SMART)
- The lightweight anti-submarine SMART version has a far greater range of around 650 km than conventional torpedoes.
- It is the fastest Anti-Submarine Warfare (ASW) missile in the world.
- The SMART was "successfully" flight-tested from the Wheeler Island off the coast of Odisha.
- Earlier in September 2020, DRDO had also successfully tested the Laser-Guided Anti Tank Guided Missile

Sagar Kavach

 Half yearly Coastal Security Exercise "Sagar Kavach" was held on October 8-9, 2020, along the coastal areas of Kerala, Karnataka and Lakshadweep to check Coastal Security mechanism and validate Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs).

Army - 2020

• The 6th International Military-Technical Forum "Army-2020" was held between August 23-29, 2020 at the Patriot Park near Moscow, Russia which was organized by Russian Defence Ministry and operated by International Congresses and Exhibitions Ltd. (ICE Ltd).

Passage Exercise (PASSEX)

- Navy ships will hold a PASSEX with USS Ronald Reagan on October 12 as it transits through the Indian Ocean
- The PASSEX is likely to be held in the waters off Kochi

offshore patrol vessel 'Vigraha

• The vessel is the one among the series of seven vessels that were designed and built for the Coast Guard.

Nirbhay land-attack cruise missile

• The subsonic missile is designed to have a strike range of 1,000km for inducting into the armed forces

<u>'Suraksha Kavach'</u>

- Indian Army organized a joint exercise 'Suraksha Kavach' along with Maharashtra Police at Lullanagar Pune
- The exercise was conducted by the Agnibaaz Division, which is a formation of Southern Command of the Indian Army

India conducts Successful Night Trial of Nuclear Capable Prithvi-2 Missile

• India successfully conducted the night trial of indigenously developed Nuclear-capable Prithvi-2 Missile at the Integrated Test Range (IPR), Balasore, Odisha. Prithvi-2 is a surface-to-surface Short Range Ballistic Missile (SRBM).

Malabar naval exercises

- India has finally invited Australia to take part in its top-notch trilateral Malabar naval exercises with the US and Japan
- The 24th edition of Malabar is scheduled to be held in the Bay of Bengal and Arabian Sea in two phases in the first and third weeks of November

• It will mark the first time the "Quad" countries will come together for the combat manoeuvres on the high seas after a gap of 13 years.

Anti - Tank Missile named as SANT

- India successfully test fired the Stand-Off Anti-Tank Missile named as SANT on October 19, 2020 from the Chandipur test range.
- The missile has been developed by the Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO).

Indigenous anti - tank guided missile (ATGM)'Nag'

- On October 22, the final user trial of the indigenous anti tank guided missile (ATGM) 'Nag' was successfully conduted at Pokhran range
- The third generation ATGM has a strike range of 4km with 'fire and forget' capabilities

INS Kavaratti

• Indian Naval Ship was formally inducted into the Navy at the Naval Dockyard in Eastern Naval command at Visakhapatnam

The Indian navy deployed its first batch of women Pilots

- The deployment was done by the Southern naval Command of Indian Navy
- The first batch includes three women pilots Lieutenant Divya Sharma, Lieutenant Shivangi and Lieutenant Shubhangi Swaroop.

Bilateral Naval Ex-Bongosagar

- The 2nd Edition of Bilateral Naval Ex-Bongosagar held between India-Bangladesh along with 3rd Edition of CORPAT
- It was held in Northern Bay of Bengal which was followed by 3rd edition of IN BN Coordinated Patrol (CORPAT) from 4 to 5 October 2020 at the same venue.

SLINEX-20

- India-Sri Lanka Navies Conducting Maritime Exercise SLINEX-20 off Trincomalee, Sri Lanka
- The exercise is being conducted in a non-contact 'at-sea-only' format amid COVID-19.

'Foundational military pact'

- India is set to sign the fourth and final 'foundational military pact' with the US during the 3rd edition of 'two-plus-two' ministerial dialogue
- The pact will be called the Basic Exchange and Cooperation Agreement for Geospatial Cooperation (BECA)

Shukrayaan - 1

- The space agency Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is credited with AstroSat, Mangalyaan Chandrayaan-1 and Chandrayaan-2.
- Now moving forward, ISRO is all set to launch its first Venus mission "Shukrayaan-1" in 2025 with participation of French space agency CNES (National Centre for Space Studies; French: Centre national d'etudes spatiales)
- In this regard, ISRO has selected the VIRAL (Venus Infrared Atmospheric Gases Linker) instrument co-developed with the Russian federal space agency Roscosmos and the LATMOS (Atmospheres, Milieux, Observations Spatiales Laborator) attached to the CNRS.
- This will be the first time a French payload will be flown on an Indian exploration mission.
- Apart from France, the Swedish Institute of Space Physics (IRF) is also participating in this mission. Through Shukrayaan-1 it will explore Venus for the second time through its satellite instrument Venusian Neutrals Analyzer (VNA).
- The decision of French coordination on Venus mission was taken during the meeting between ISRO Chairman Kailasavadivoo (K) Sivan and President of France's CNES Jean-Yves Le Gall on September 30, 2020.
- ISRO intends to send the Shukrayaan orbiter mission to Venus in order to study the dense and hot atmosphere of Venus, primarily consisting of carbon dioxide.
- The French payload will be flown on an Indian exploration mission for the first time
- The mission will study the atmospheric chemistry, compositional variations and dynamics of Planet Venus.

Nuclear - capable Surface - to -Surface Missile, "Shaurya"

• Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully testfired a new version of indigenously developed canister launched hypersonic nuclear-capable Shaurya missile from the Abdul Kalam Island test range off Dhamra, Odisha to a target in Bay of Bengal. • Shaurya, a surface-to-surface medium range missile is a land version of Submarine Launched Ballistic Missile (SLBM) K-15 (B-05) and can be used by both the Navy and the Army

ICG Offshore Patrol Vessel 'Vigraha' launched to enhance Coastal Security

- The Seventh Offshore Patrol Vessel (OPV) 'Vigraha' of Indian Coast Guard (ICG) was launched at Kattupalli Port, Chennai
- This is the first time that a private sector shipyard has designed & constructed an offshore patrol vessel class ship.
- 'Vigraha' is the last in the series of Seven OPVs contracted to Larsen & Toubro by the Defence Ministry in 2015.

Anti - Radiation missile called 'Rudram'

- India successfully test-fired its first indigenous anti-radiation missile, Rudram 1, a New Generation Anti-Radiation Missile (NGARM) integrated on Su-30MKI fighter aircraft of Indian Air Force.
- They developed by Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), this air-to-surface missile was tested at the interim test range Balasore, off the coast of Odisha in the Bay of Bengal
- They can play a key role in neutralising any jamming platforms of the enemy and clear the path for the fighter jets

<u>Indian Navy Warship INS Kora Test-fires Anti-Ship Missile (AShM) in Bay of Bengal</u>

• Indian Navy's Guided Missile Corvette INS Kora (Indian Naval Ship) tested fired Anti-Ship Missile (AShM) in Bay Of Bengal The missile successfully hit the target at maximum range with precise accuracy

Nirbhay Cruise Missile

- Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) launched the Nirbhay Cruise Missile from Odisha's test facility, the mission was aborted due to technical snag.
- Nirbhay is India's first indigenously developed Cruise Missile and has been developed by Advanced System Laboratory (ASL).

Bills / Acts

- Parlialment passed Code on Wages Bill, 2019
- This new code was brought in by combining the features of three erstwhile laws the Trade Unions Act, 1926, the Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946, and the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 for hiring and firing of labour in mid-sized and large industries.
- Firms with more than 300 workers need to still apply for approval, however, if the authorities do not respond to their request, it will be deemed as approved.
- In the case of manufacturing units, plantations, and mines with 100 or more workmen, lay-offs also required government approval.

Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020:

- It amends laws regulating occupational safety, health and working conditions of employees by replacing 13 old central labour laws.
- It empowers a state government to exempt any new factory from the provisions of the Code to create more economic activity and jobs.
- It fixes the maximum daily work limit at **eight hours a day**.
- Women are entitled to be employed in all establishments for all types of work with adequate safeguards in case of work in hazardous operations.

Code on Social Security, 2020:

- This code replaces **9 laws** to provide universal social security for the first time for both organised and informal workers as well as gig and platform workers.
- As per this code the government will formulate and notify, from time to time, suitable welfare schemes, including schemes relating to provident fund, employment injury benefit, housing, educational schemes for children, skill upgradation of workers, funeral assistance; and old age homes.
- It also lays down the setting up of a National Social Security Board to recommend the central government suitable schemes for unorganised workers.

Code on Wages, 2019:

- It consolidates and simplifies **4 laws** viz. Payment of Wages Act, 1936, Minimum Wages Act, 1948, Payment of Bonus Act, 1965 and Equal Remuneration Act, 1976 into a single code. The previous four laws had a total of 119 sections while this new Code has 69 sections.
- It aims to provide statutory protection for minimum wages and timely payment of wages.

Amendments to Companies law get President's assent:

- The Companies (Amendment) Bill, 2020 that also seeks to promote ease of doing business in the country has received assent from the President. This Companies (Amendment) Act, 2020 replaces the Companies Act, 2013.
- This bill will make changes in the 65 clauses, including amendments to **61 sections** of the Companies Act, 2013. A new chapter related to producer organisation is also introduced in the Act.
- Decriminalisation of various offences, reduction in penalties for certain offences as well as in timeline for rights issues, relaxation in CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) compliance requirements and creation of separate benches at the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (NCLAT) are also among the amendments.

Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Amendment Act, 2020

- Since 1976, the FCRA regulates foreign donations in ensuring that such contributions don't adversely affect internal security.
- It was amended in 2010.
- It is applicable to all associations, groups, and NGOs which intend to receive foreign donations and thus make them mandatory to register themselves under the FCRA.
- It changes under Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Amendment Act, 2020

Aadhar requirement mandated:

- Aadhaar numbers by office-bearers of NGOs has become mandatory for registration.
- In case of a foreigner, a copy of the passport or the Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card is required.
- **Reduction in administrative expense cap:** The act also lowered the administrative expenses of any NGO receiving foreign funding to 20% from the existing 50% of annual funds by amending Section 8 of FCRA
- Bars public servants from receiving funds from abroad
- Transfer of foreign contribution prohibited
- Forbidding of foreign contribution recipient from utilising/receiving its funds
- FCRA bank account in SBI, Delhi Mandated: As per the amendment of Section 17 of FCRA, the foreign contribution can be received only in "FCRA Account" opened in the State Bank of India (SBI) branch in New Delhi.

New labour law codes passed by Parliament

- The three bills includes The Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code of Social Security, 2020
- These bills are the part of government's labour reform agenda
- Accordingly, all the existing labour laws are brought into four labour codes on wages, industrial relations, social security and safety, health and working conditions

Hyperloop Corridors from BLR Airport

• Bangalore International Airport Limited (BIAL) and Virgin Hyperloop signed a first-of-its-kind Memorandum of understanding (MoU) to conduct a feasibility study for Hyperloop corridor from Kempegowda International Airport, Bengaluru(KIAB/BLR airport).

NABARD to Undertake Sanitation Literacy Campaign to Promote Literacy on "WASH"

• The National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development(NABARD) to undertake a Sanitation Literacy Campaign (SLC) to promote literacy on "WASH" (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene) in 2,000 villages across the country covering 1 lakh rural population. SLC will start from October 2, 2020 to January 26, 2021.

Wash Programme

- National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) launched a special refinance scheme to support the government's Water, Sanitisation and Hygiene (WASH) programme.
- This facility is an effort to promote a sustainable and healthy lifestyle in rural areas

- The Index, which was released on October 16, is a peer-reviewed report released annually by Concern Worldwide and Welthungerhilfe
- In 2019, India was ranked 102 out of 117 countries and in 2018 it was ranked 103 among 119 countries

The National Crime Records Bureau - 2019

• As per the report, cyber crimes registered a massive 63.5% rise in 2019

- Fraud emerged as the main motive of the cybercrimes registered in 2019, constituting 60.4% or 26,891 cases followed by sexual exploitation
- Karnataka reported the highest cyber crimes at 12,020, followed by Uttar Pradesh (11,416) and Maharashtra (4,967).
- However, crimes against women and children showed a 7.3% and 4.5% rise respectively
- Crime rate refers to the number of crimes registered per lakh population

National crime Records Bureau

- Nine states accounted for 84% of all crimes against dalits in India in 2019
- The highest crime rates (number of crimes for every lakh population of dalits) were observed in Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar and Gujarat.
- The other states with crime rates above the national average were Telangana, Uttar Pradesh, Kerala, Odisha and Andhra Pradesh.
- As per the data, the national conviction rate in offences under the SC/ST Atrocities Act was just 32% and the pendency rate of cases an alarming 94%.
