

TNPSC GROUP I MAIN 2021 ADVISORY FOR HOME TEST

Test - Online Procedure

1. The time schedule for Home Test is as mentioned below:

Saturday: 10 am - 1 pm Wednesday: 10 am - 1 pm

- 2. The question paper will be posted in the respective **student's login**, along with that a Google Form Link will be sent for uploading the scanned copy of the written answer booklet.
- 3. After completion of the examination each and every page should be scanned visibly. Upload the scanned copy of the answer scripts and the front page of answer book to the **Google Form Link in the PDF Format**. Check whether all the pages are in the appropriate order before uploading.
- 4. Follow the time limit and be sincere in your test presentation.
- 5. Upload the answer booklets within the stipulated time mentioned below: Saturday: Before 2 pm Wednesday: Before 2 pm
- 6. The reason for uploading the scanned copy is to find out whether the test is completed at the appropriate time
- 7. The Zoom App video should be in the "on mode" throughout the three hours of the stipulated test time and it will be strictly monitored by the invigilation team. (Use the same Zoom Link that was provided for the online classes).
- 8. The aspirants, who are able to submit the answer booklets in person to "APPOLO STUDY CENTRE" within **one hour** from the stipulated completion of the test time, are advised **not to upload** the answer booklets in the provided Google Form Link.

EVALUATION - PROCEDURE

- 1. For Evaluation Purpose, it is mandatory to send the answer booklets to Appolo Study Centre in person or through courier on the day of the test or the following day.
- 2. The evaluated answer sheets can be collected in person or can be sent through courier to the aspirant's postal address.
- 3. The aspirants who wanted their evaluated answer booklets to be sent back to their postal address in courier should mention "courier" on top of the front page of the answer booklet.
- 4. The Key and content discussion on the test will be organised online.
- 5. The aspirants should prepare for the test with a positive frame of mind.
