TAMIL NADU

> Food Security Museum

- ✓ Union Minister for Commerce, Industry, Food, and Public Distribution Piyush Goyal on 15 November 2021, virtually launched India's first Food Security Museum in Thanjavur, Tamil Nadu.
- ✓ The museum showcases India's agriculture revolution from dependency to self-sufficiency.

> Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission (TNERC)

- ✓ The Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission (TNERC) has framed regulations for solar power generation plants and fixed tariffs for low tension (LT) consumers and high tension (HT) consumers.
- ✓ The regulations were issued by TNERC on November 15.
- ✓ The new regulations are aimed at boosting solar power installations in the state and to encourage small land holders to get into solar power generation.

> Thooya Tamizh Patralar Award

- ✓ 18-year-old V Varatharajan wins 'Thooya Tamizh Patralar' award.
- ✓ The Thooya Tamizh Patralar award instituted by the Tamil Nadu government, has been conferred on V Varatharajan, an 18-year old student from Melur.
- ✓ The award was instituted to honour those who use pure Tamil in daily life.

> Tamil Film Koozhangal

- ✓ Tamil film Koozhangal selected to be screened at IFFI 2021, the Indian Panorama segment in the 52 International Film Festival Goa.
- ✓ Koozhangal is also India's official entry for Academy Award for Oscars.

> Tancem's 'Valimai' Cement Brand

- ✓ Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on Tuesday launched 'Valimai' a new cement brand from the Tamil Nadu Cements Corporation Limited (Tancem), a State government undertaking.
- ✓ The two varieties of the Valimai cement brand are priced at 350 and 365 a bag.

Pongal Gift Hampers

✓ On November 17, Chief Minister M K Stalin - announced Pongal gift hampers for 2.15 crore PDS family cardholders in the state.

✓ The gift hampers costing 1,088 crore will be given to rice cardholders and Sri Lankan Tamils staying in rehabilitation centres during the Pongal festival in January 2022.

Madras Sappers

- ✓ The Madras Sappers celebrated its 241st Corps Day on 18 November 2021.
- ✓ The Indian Army's Corps of Engineers officially recognizes its birth in 1780 when the oldest group of the Corps, the Madras Sappers, was raised.

> Innuyir Kaappom Thittam

- ✓ Tamil Nadu has become the first state in the country to offer free 81 lifesaving emergency treatment procedures to accident victims for two days of their hospitalisation.
- ✓ The procedures worth 1 lakh can be availed at 609 empanelled government and private hospitals in the state.
- ✓ The scheme **Nammai Kaakkum 48** (saving our lives in 48 hours) was announced by the Government on November 18.
- ✓ The scheme will cover all those who don't have any insurance schemes.
- ✓ The state has set aside 50 crore for the first phase of implementation of the 'Innuyir Kaappom Thittam' (saving precious lives).

> Silambam

- ➤ Silambam or stick fencing is a pre-historic ancient martial art form which originated in Tamil Nadu.
- ✓ On November 18, the Tamil Nadu government included 'Silambam' as one of the sporting disciplines which will be eligible under the 3% sports quota for recruitment in public sector undertakings (PSUs) and government departments.
- ✓ Silambam was included as one of the sports disciplines for consideration under the sports quota for admission into professional courses like medical, engineering, law, etc.

> V O Chidambaram's Literary Works

- ✓ On November 18, Chief Minister M K Stalin unveiled books on freedom fighter V O Chidambaram's literary works at the Secretariat to mark the beginning of the year-long celebration of his 150th birth anniversary.
- ✓ The first volume of the compendium of VOC's works (V.O.C Pannool Thirattu) and the second volume of VOC's speech on 'Thirukkural' (V.O.C. Thirukkural Urai) were published by Tamil Nadu Textbook and Educational Services Corporation (TNTBESC).

> National Highways

- ✓ On November 18, Chief minister M K Stalin requested Prime Minister Narendra Modi to declare eight state roads in Tamil Nadu as national highways.
- ✓ In this regard, the CM requested the Centre to direct the Union ministry of road transport and highways (MoRTH) and entrust the development work with the state government with requisite funding.

FinTech Governing Council

- ✓ On November 19, the Tamil Nadu government formed a FinTech governing council comprising members from the government and the industry
- ✓ It has been formed based on the recommendation of the Tamil Nadu State Planning Commission.
- ✓ The council will form sub-committees to address various aspects in the upcoming Fin-Tech Policy such as marketing and branding, business development and outreach, partnerships, education, venture capital and regulation.

➤ Helpline Number '14417

- ✓ The government to print the helpline number '14417' in all the school textbooks to create awareness about child abuse and harassment among the student community as well the general public.
- ✓ The helpline number,14417, was created specifically for school students, teachers, and parents to extend counselling.

> Tamil Nadu State Planning Commission

- ✓ Vidya Mahambare, professor of Economics and Program Director, PGDM, at Great Lakes Institute of Management, Chennai has been appointed on the expert committee of the Tamil Nadu State Planning Commission.
- ✓ The appointment has been made for the commission's preparation of the state's draft policy on 'Employability and Skilling for a Transitioning Economy'.

> Tamil Nadu State Policy for Children 2021

- ✓ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on 20 November 2021 launched the Tamil Nadu State Child Policy.
- ✓ The policy has been formulated taking holistically the needs of the children like their growth targets in their various stages, nutrition, education, healthcare, etc.
- ✓ He also launched the Forensic DNA Profile Search Tool that would enable restoring the lost children to their parents.

Chennai Metropolitan Area Project

- ✓ AIIB approves USD 150 million loans for Chennai Metropolitan Area project.
- ✓ The Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) has approved \$150 million loans to India for the implementation of the Sustainable Urban services program for the Chennai metropolitan area (CMA).

➤ 3-D Eye Surgery Facility

- ✓ India's first 3-D eye surgery facility inaugurated in Chennai.
- ✓ Tamil Nadu Health Minister Ma Subramanian inaugurated India's first 3D eye surgery facility at a government hospital in Chennai on 19 November 2021.
- ✓ The country"s first three-dimensional eye surgery facility has been developed at Chennai's Egmore Eye Hospital.

▶ Bala Sabhas

- ✓ T.N. to get 'bala sabhas' in all panchayats.
- ✓ The creation of 'bala sabhas' at all village panchayats for children aged 12 to 18, on the lines of gram sabhas, the introduction of a child protection policy at all panchayats and urban bodies and a child safeguarding policy at all schools are among the provisions envisioned in the Tamil Nadu State Policy for Children, 2021, released by Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on Saturday.

> DNA Profile-Based Search Tool

- ✓ On November 20, Chief Minister M K Stalin inaugurated a new DNA profile-based search tool at the Secretariat.
- ✓ The new device will help trace abandoned children, inter-state criminals and child sexual predators among others.
- ✓ Tamil Nadu has become the first state in the country to get the state-of-the-art device as part of the efforts to modernise the state forensic department.

> Swachh Survekshan Report

- ✓ Chennai improved its ranking in cleanliness in 2021 by securing 43rd spot in the Swachh Survekshan report for 2021 released on November 20.
- ✓ Swachh Survekshan is an annual survey of cleanliness, hygiene and sanitation in cities and towns across India
- ✓ It was launched as part of the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, which aims to make India clean and free of open defecation.

Palar River

✓ Palar witnessing flows never seen before.

- ✓ Originating from the Nandi Hills in Karnataka, the Palar flows down to Tamil Nadu through Andhra Pradesh. Of its total length of 348 km, 93 km lies in Karnataka, 33 km in Andhra Pradesh and 222 km in Tamil Nadu.
- ✓ The river, having seven tributaries, enters Tamil Nadu near Vaniyambadi. It covers many important towns such as Vellore and Kancheepuram.

Tamil Nadu - Investors' first Port of Call' Conclave

✓ On November 23, the Tamil Nadu government - signed 59 MoUs for projects worth 35,208 crore across various sectors, including areospace and defence, which are expected to create 76,795 direct employment opportunities.

FinTech Policy

- ✓ On November 23, Chief Minister M K Stalin unveiled a FinTech Policy for the state and released a handbook on aerospace and defence systems at the investment conclave in Coimbatore.
- ✓ The Tamil Nadu FinTech Policy 2021 has set a vision to transform the State into a leading global destination for fintech firms by 2025 and aims to develop Chennai as a FinTech hub.

> The Tamil Nadu school education department

✓ The Tamil Nadu school education department - has decided to add the 'medium of instruction' for all classes on the Class X mark sheets from this year.

> 4GW Integrated Solar Photovoltaic Cell

✓ Tata Group's solar power arm – is in talks with the Tamil Nadu government to set up a 4GW integrated solar photovoltaic cell manufacturing unit in Gangaikondan near Tirunelveli.

Vir Chakra Award - Tamil Nadu soldier

- ✓ More than 20 Indian soldiers were killed in a clash between Chinese and Indian forces in the Kalwan Valley on June 15 last year.
- ✓ Palani from Tamil Nadu was one of the notables. The Vir Chakra award was given in his honour.

> Welspun One

- ✓ Welspun One signs MoU with Tamil Nadu to invest Rs 2500 crore.
- ✓ Welspun One Logistics Parks (WOLP) has signed an MoU with Guidance the Government of Tamil Nadu's nodal agency.
- ✓ It has been signed for investment promotion and single window facilitation.

> L&T

- ✓ L&T signs pact with Tamil Nadu to build data centre at Kanchipuram.
- ✓ Larsen & Toubro (L&T) has entered into a pact with the Tamil Nadu government to establish a data center in the state.

➤ Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Urban Index

- ✓ Chennai has been ranked 11th among 56 cities in the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Urban Index.
- ✓ The NITI Aayog report considered 16 goals including 'no poverty', good health and well-being, quality education, reduced inequalities, climate action, life below water and on land and peace, justice and strong institutions to arrive at a composite score for the index.

> National Family Health Survey (NFHS) 5

- ✓ T.N. ahead in Reproductive, Child Health.
- ✓ With significant improvements in several social and health parameters, when compared with the previous edition, the National Family Health Survey (NFHS) 5 seems to have set the State on its regular path ahead yet again, particularly in reproductive and child health.

> Vaccination

✓ While the drastic reduction in vaccination rates during NFHS 4 was disconcerting for a State that is usually ahead of the national averages, particularly in the health sector, it is of some solace that the vaccination rates are climbing back up. From lower down the scale at 69.7% during the 2015-16 assessment, the percentage of fully vaccinated children in the 12-23 months age group has risen to 89.2% in the current assessment (2019-2021).

> Green Certification

- ➤ The Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board had announced 'Green Certification' for schools in Chennai.
- ✓ The certification will be provided for the schools to which the children come either by walk or by riding bicycles.

> Advisory Panel

✓ On November 25, the Tamil Nadu government - formed an advisory panel to harness the strength of the Tamil diaspora and streamline investments into the state.

✓ The panel will strive to tap the potential of the global Tamil community, members of which are in various positions of influence in public and private institutions, to promote business investments into the State.

➤ Guidelines For the Release of 700 Life Convicts

- ✓ Tamil Nadu government released a set of guidelines for the release of 700 life convicts in the state jails.
- ✓ The completion of at least 10 years in jail is the basic eligibility for the premature release.
- ✓ The premature release, under Article 161 of the Constitution, is to mark the 113th birth anniversary of former chief minister C N Annadurai.

> Covid Vaccination

- ✓ 100% first installment dose district Kanchipuram.
- ✓ So far more than 76% of people in Tamil Nadu have been vaccinated with the first dose and 40% with the second dose.Kanchipuram is the first district to get 100% first dose of vaccine.

> Nimirndhu Nil, Thunindhu Sol

- ✓ The Karur district administration launched the initiative 'Nimirndhu Nil, Thunindhu Sol' to dispel fear among school girls to report sexual assault
- ✓ As part of the scheme, a questionnaire seeking personal details including name, class, school, address, parents' mobile number and information on sexual abuse on them or their friends in school or near their houses was given to the students.

➤ 100cm Rain

- ✓ Chennai has recorded more than 100cm rain in November for the third time in nearly 100 years, with Chennai Nungambakkam weather station crossing the 100cm mark.
- ✓ As per Meteorologists, the Chennai-based observatory recorded the highest rainfall for November in 1918 with 1088mm, followed by 1049mm in 2015.
- ✓ Chennai's normal rainfall for the entire North East monsoon season is 87cm.

Initiative for Women's Safety Launched

- ✓ To mark the "International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women November 25", the 'Niruthuda Women's movement' was formally launched by Karunalaya Social Service Society on Thursday.
- ✓ The members of the Nirthuda movement met police officials last year and urged them to look into complaints of violence against women and take action immediately.

STATES

Purvanchal Expressway

- ✓ Prime Minister Narendra Modi has inaugurated the 341-km long Purvanchal Express in Sultanpur district, Uttar Pradesh.
- ✓ The expressway links state capital Lucknow with Ghazipur and has been constructed at an estimated cost of Rs 22,500 crore.
- ✓ The key feature of the Expressway is the 3.2 km long airstrip to enable landing and take-off of Indian Air Force fighter planes in case of emergency.

Agartala City Urban Development Project

- ✓ India and ADB sign \$61 million loan for Agartala.
- ✓ The Indian government and Asian Development Bank (ADB) signed a \$61 million loan in November 2021.
- ✓ It has been signed to improve livability, harness technology, and promote new developments to accommodate the expanding population in Agartala, Tripura.

Pakke Tiger Reserve 2047 Declaration on Climate Change

- ✓ Arunachal Pradesh Cabinet adopts declaration on climate change.
- ✓ The state cabinet, headed by Chief Minister Pema Khandu, adopted the Pakke Tiger Reserve 2047 Declaration on Climate Change-Resilient and Responsive Arunachal Pradesh. The declaration is aimed at lowering emissions and achieving sustainable development.

Pochampally in Telangana

- ✓ The Pochampally village in Telangana has been selected as one of the best Tourism Villages by the UN World Tourism Organisation (UNWTO).
- ✓ The award will be given on the occasion of the 24th session of the UNWTO General Assembly on 2 Dec 2021 in Madrid, Spain.
- ✓ Pochampally is often referred to as the Silk City of India.

➤ World Food Programme (WFP)

- ✓ The Meghalaya government has signed an MoU with the United Nations World Food Programme to streamline and strengthen the public distribution system in the state.
- ✓ The partnership will help the WFP authorities and the state government work together towards Sustainable Development Goal two Zero Hunger.

Clean Yamuna River

- ✓ The Chief Minister of Delhi, Arvind Kejriwal, pledged to clean Yamuna River completely by 2025.
- ✓ He announced a six-point action plan to clean the holy river.
- ✓ He also promised to make Yamuna River fit for drinking and bathing by 2025.

> School Transformation Program

- ✓ On November 16, 2021, Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik inaugurated 130 refurbished schools as part of the state's educational reform initiative.
- ✓ The school transformation programme was established with the goal of instilling
 a competitive mindset among students in order to achieve academic achievement.

Best Performing Marine District

- ✓ Balasore awarded 'Best Performing Marine District' in India.
- ✓ For the first time, a district from Odisha got this award.
- ✓ Andhra Pradesh was awarded the Best Marine State, while Telangana got Best Inland State Award.

> Rani Gaidinliu Tribal Freedom Fighters Museum

- ✓ Home Minister to lay foundation stone of Rani Gaidinliu Tribal Freedom Fighters
 Museum in Manipur.
- ✓ Union Minister of Home Affairs Amit Shah will lay the foundation stone of the Rani Gaidinliu Tribal freedom fighters Museum at Luangkao village, Tamenglong District in Manipur on November 22, 2021 through video conference.

> Learning Transformation Project

- ✓ India, World Bank sign loan worth \$250 million to improve learning across Andhra Pradesh.
- ✓ The Central Government, the state government of Andhra Pradesh, and the World_Bank on November 18, 2021, signed a loan agreement worth \$250 million for the Supporting Andhra's Learning Transformation Project which aims to improve the quality of learning for more than 50 lakh students in Andhra Pradesh.

Patalpani Railway Station

- ✓ Madhya Pradesh CM Shivraj Singh Chouhan has announced that Patalpani railway station in Indore will be renamed as Tantya Mama railway station.
- ✓ Indore Bus Stand will also be named after him.
- ✓ Tantya Bhil or Tantya Mama was a dacoit (bandit) active in India between 1878 and 1889.
- ✓ He is recognized by Indians as a heroic figure.

> (SALT) Project

- ✓ Government of Andhra Pradesh, Union government and the World Bank have signed legal agreements for a loan of \$250 million for the "Supporting Andhra's Learning Transformation (SALT) project".
- ✓ SALT project aims to improve the quality of learning for more than 50 lakh students in the state of Andhra Pradesh.

Mukhyamantri Tirth Yatra Yojana

- ✓ The Delhi government decided to include Kartarpur Sahib in Punjab province of Pakistan and Velankanni Church in Tamil Nadu to its pilgrimage scheme called "Mukhyamantri Tirth Yatra Yojana".
- ✓ Under the scheme, Delhi government will provide travel packages for free pilgrimage to senior citizens of the state, who are above 60 years.

> First Cyber Tehsil of India

- ✓ Madhya Pradesh Cabinet has approved the proposal to create cyber tehsils in the state of Madhya Pradesh.
- ✓ After this, MP will become the first state in the country to have a cyber tehsil. Cyber Tehsil will make the mutation process easy and people from anywhere in the state can avail of its benefit. With this, the process of conversion will become convenient in the cases of undisputed land.

> STREET Project

- ✓ Kerala Tourism to launch 'STREET project' across seven districts to enrich visitor experience and take tourism deep into the interior regions of the state
- ✓ The STREET is an acronym for "Sustainable, Tangible, Responsible, Experiential, Ethnic, Tourism" hubs.
 - The project is conceived by the Responsible Tourism Mission and inspired by the 'Tourism for Inclusive Growth' slogan of The United Nations World Tourism Organization (UNWTO).

NATIONAL

➤ Grass Conservatory

- ✓ India gets first 'Grass Conservatory' in Uttarakhand's Almora district.
- ✓ India's first grass conservation centre has been set up at the Kalika Forest Research Center of Ranikhet in Uttarakhand.
- ✓ The grass is the most economically important of all flowering plants because of its nutritious grain and soil-forming function.

> Tax Devolution

- ✓ Centre to release over 95 thousand crore rupees as tax devolution to States this month.
- ✓ Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman has said that the Centre will release 95 thousand 82 crore rupees as tax devolution to States in the current month after including one advance instalment to help them push their capital expenditure.

> Bhumi Samvaad

- ✓ The Union Minister for Rural Development and Panchayati Raj Giriraj Singh has inaugurated 'Bhumi Samvaad'.
- ✓ It is a national workshop on the digital India land record modernization programme.

> Rashtra Raksha Samparpan Parv

- ✓ Three day Rashtra Raksha Samparpan Parv will be held in Jhansi, Uttar Pradesh as part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebrations.
- ✓ 19th of November is the Birth Anniversary of Rani Lakshmi Bai, the epitome of bravery and courage and a great National icon of Rashtra Raksha and India's Independence struggle.

Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF)

- ✓ On November 17, the Union Cabinet cleared utilisation of the Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) for provision of mobile connectivity in 7,287 uncovered villages.
- ✓ These uncovered villages of 44 aspirational districts across five states of Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Maharashtra and Odisha will get 4G-based mobile services.

Covovax

✓ Covishield maker Serum Institute of India (SII) – to start the paediatric trial of Covovax by including children in the 2-6 years age bracket across 10 sites in India.

> Indian Railways

- ✓ The first pod hotel of the Indian Railways was inaugurated virtually by Raosaheb Danve, Union minister of state for Railways, from the Churchgate station in Mumbai on November 17.
- ✓ The pod hotel, also known as capsule hotels, has several small bed-sized capsules and provides overnight accommodation at affordable rates.

➤ LINAC- NCDC Fisheries Business Incubation Centre (LIFIC)

- ✓ The first-of-its-kind, dedicated fisheries business incubator has been inaugurated in Gurugram of Haryana to nurture fisheries start-ups under real market-led conditions.
- ✓ The incubator is known as LINAC- NCDC Fisheries Business Incubation Centre (LIFIC). The centre has been established at a cost of Rs. 3.23 crore under the central flagship Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY).

➤ New Model Concession Agreement - 2021 announced

- ✓ Union Minister for Ports, Shipping and Waterways Sarbananda Sonowal on 18 November 2021 announced the revised Model Concession Agreement (MCA) -2021 for PPP (Public-Private Partnership) projects at Major Ports.
- ✓ It will be applicable to all the future PPP projects at major ports, as well as projects which are under bidding stage.

> Rezang La War Memorial

- ✓ Union Defence Minister Rajnath Singh inaugurated a newly revamped war memorial in Ladakh's Rezang La, on 18 November 2021.
- ✓ The memorial has names of soliders who died in the June 2020 Galwan Valley clash with the Chinese.
- ✓ 18 November is marked as this battle's anniversary.

> Centre to Roll Back Three Farm Laws

- ✓ Prime Minister Narendra Modi has announced that his government will repeal the three contentious agricultural laws and requested protesting farmers to go back to their fields and homes.
- **➤** The Three Contentious Bills:
- ✓ The Farmer's Produce Trade and Commerce (Promotion and Facilitation) Bill, 2020.
- ✓ The Farmers (Empowerment and Protection) Agreement of Price Assurance and Farm Services Bill, 2020.
- ✓ The Farmers' Produce Trade and Commerce (Promotion and Facilitation) Bill.

> Sustainable Development Cell

- ✓ Ministry of coal has constituted a "Sustainable Development Cell", in line with the commitment of clean energy.
- ✓ The Sustainable Development Cell was constituted in the backdrop of Prime Minister's announcement on new climate targets at COP26 under 'Panchamrit Strategy'.

> Panchayats (Extension to Scheduled Areas) Act 1996 (PESA)

- ✓ The Centre has asked Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Odisha to expedite notification and implementation of the rules of the Panchayats (Extension to Scheduled Areas) Act 1996 (PESA).
- ✓ These four states account for a significant part of India's tribal population.
- ✓ The provisions of the PESA Act seek to empower local self-governments in the Schedule V areas of the country to help safeguard and preserve the traditions and customs of the tribal communities.

➤ India's Cleanest City

- ✓ Madhya Pradesh's Indore city has been declared as India's cleanest city for 5th time in a row under the Centre's Swachh Survekshan 2021 on 20 November 2021.
- ✓ Surat (Gujarat) and Vijaywada (Andhra Pradesh) grabbed the second and third positions respectively.
- ✓ Among Indian states, Chhattisgarh has bagged top position as the country's cleanest state.

> BSNL and MTNL

- ✓ The Centre has started the process of auctioning non-core assets of the two loss-making state-run telecom companies, BSNL and MTNL.
- ✓ The Department of Investment and Public Asset Management (Dipam) has
 invited bids on the MSTC portal for six properties of BSNL and MTNL
- ✓ This commences the non-core asset monetisation of the two struggling telecom PSUs in a phased manner.

TRIFED Aadi Mahotsav

✓ Russian Navy successfully test-fired the 'Zircon' Hypersonic Cruise Missile from Frigate – Admiral Gorshkov warship, which rightly hit the test target placed in the Russian Arctic waters.

> Cryptocarya Muthuvariana

- ✓ The plant was discovered by a team of scientists from the University of Kerala and the Jawaharlal Nehru Tropical Botanical Garden and Research Institute (TBGRI).
- ✓ Cryptocaria Muthuvariana, a new species of the plant is named after the Muthuvar tribal group, has been discovered.
- ✓ For the first time in the state's history, a plant species has been named after a local tribe.

➤ Laser Communications Relay Demonstration (LCRD)

- ✓ NASA is set to test a "Laser Communications Relay Demonstration (LCRD) technology" in space, with the aim of speeding up space communications.

> DART Spacecraft

- ✓ The world's first planetary defense system called the DART spacecraft was successfully launched by NASA on 24 November 2021.

- ✓ This was stated in a new report by the research arm of consultants McKinsey & Co. that examines the national balance sheets of ten countries.
- ✓ Net worth worldwide rose to \$514 trn in 2020, from \$156 trn in 2000.
- ✓ China accounted for almost one-third of the increase.

> WHO - World Health Organization

- ✓ Number of tobacco users decreased globally since 2015: WHO.
- ✓ World Health Organization (WHO) published the 4th edition of Global report on trends in prevalence of tobacco use 2000-2025.

- ✓ The United States (US) was its biggest source, accounting for over 20% of these funds.
- ✓ In India, remittances are projected to grow 3% in 2022 to USD 89.6 billion.

✓ It is for the first time that such change in course has been reported from a Himalayan glacier.

➤ NITI Aayog Poverty Index

- ✓ Bihar, Jharkhand, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Meghalaya have emerged as the poorest states in India, as per NITI Aayog's Multidimensional Poverty Index.
- ✓ Over 50% of the population in Bihar is classified as multidimensionally poor.
- ✓ Kerala, Goa, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, and Punjab have registered the lowest poverty across India and are at the bottom of the index.

➤ Word of the Year 2021

- ✓ 'NFT', an abbreviation of the word 'non-fungible token', was revealed as Collins Dictionary Word of the Year 2021.
- ✓ Collins Dictionary defines NFT as a unique digital certificate, registered in a blockchain, that is used to record the ownership of an asset such as an artwork or a collectible.

ASER 2021 - SURVEY REPORT

> Enrolment in Government Schools in Rural India

- ✓ Enrolment in government schools in rural India crossed 70%, even higher than pre-Covid days.
- ✓ This was revealed in the Annual Status of Education (Rural) (ASER-2021) survey report
- ✓ The survey was held across 25 states and three UTs.
- ✓ Gender-wise enrolment in government schools for girls is at 80% in 2021.
- ✓ State-wise, Uttar Pradesh (13.2%) and Kerala (11.9%) registered maximum increase in government school enrolment.

> Smartphone Ownership

- ✓ The smartphone ownership in Tamil Nadu has increased from 40% in 2018 to 66.1% in 2021.
- ✓ This was revealed in the 2021 Annual Status of Education Report (ASER).
- ✓ One in three students in rural Tamil Nadu does not have a smartphone at home, as per the report.

India's Total Fertility Rate (TFR)

- ✓ India's total fertility rate (TFR) or the average number of children born to a woman over her lifetime has dropped below replacement level for the first time and stands at 2 now.
- ✓ The replacement level TFR, at which a population exactly replaces itself from one generation to the next, is estimated to be 2.1.
- ✓ This was revealed in the fifth edition of National Family Health Survey (NFHS) data for 2019-21.
- ✓ It was released by the International Institute of Population Sciences for the phase-2 states along with all-India data on November 24.

> National Family and Health Survey: India has more women than men

- ✓ All three radical findings are part of the summary findings of the fifth round of the National Family and Health Survey (NFHS), which were released by the Union health ministry.
- ✓ India now has 1,020 women for every 1000 men, is not getting any younger, and no longer faces the threat of a population explosion.
- ✓ According to NFHS-3, conducted in 2005-06, the ratio was equal, 1000: 1000; it went down to 991:1000 in 2015-16 in NFHS-4.
- ✓ This is the first time, in any NFHS or Census, that the sex ratio is skewed in favour of women.

➤ SMART Policing Index

- ✓ Andhra Pradesh and Telangana were rated with the highest 'SMART policing index' score of 8.11 and 8.1 respectively on a scale of 1-10.
- ✓ SMART is an acronym for reforms to be introduced in the police department.

- ✓ Andhra Pradesh secured first rank among police forces of the country in a survey conducted by the Indian Police Foundation (IPF).
- ✓ The survey, conducted in 29 states and Union Territories of the country assessed the force on competence, values, and public trust.
- ✓ Telangana ranked second while Assam was third.

- ✓ The Sadar Bazar police station in Delhi has been ranked as the best police station of India for the year 2021 by the Ministry of Home Affairs.
