# TAMIL NADU

## ➤ Tamil Nadu Government Honours 9 ISRO Scientists

- ✓ In a heartwarming gesture, the Tamil Nadu government recently felicitated nine eminent scientists from the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and announced a generous award of 2.25 crore.
- ISRO Chairman K Sivan, Chandrayaan-1 and 2
- Project Director, Mylswamy Annadurai
- Director of Liquid Propulsion Systems Centre- ISRO V Narayanan
- Director of Satish Dhawan Space Centre, A Rajarajan
- Distinguished ISRO Scientist, M Sankaran

- ISRO's M Vanitha
- ISRO's Nigar Shaji

- ✓ This noble recognition is a testament to the tireless efforts and groundbreaking achievements of these scientists in the field of space research.
  - ✓ Chief Minister announced cash awards of Rs.25 lakh for each of the scientists and unveiled plans for a scholarship program to encourage scientific innovation among postgraduate engineering students.
  - ✓ Chief Minister highlighted the remarkable journey of these scientists, noting that six of the nine had their education in government schools in Tamil Nadu.
- ## ➤ Thoothukudi's' Udangudi Panangkarupatti gets GI tag
- ✓ The Intellectual Property of India (IPI) on Tuesday conferred a Geographical Indication (GI) tag for the famous 'Udangudi Panangkarupatti', a product widely

associated with the Tirunelveli District Palmyrah Products Cooperative Federation Limited.



- ✓ The Geographical Indications Registry recognised the uniqueness of the delicacy known since time immemorial, for its sucrose concentration, sap collection method, traditional method of preparation, and packaging methods.
- ✓ Besides Udangudi Panangkarupatti, Thoothukudi is home to two other products that have been conferred with the GI tag, including Kovilpatti Kadalaimittai, and Authoor Vetrillai.

➤ **Passenger Ferry Service between T.N. and Sri Lanka**

- ✓ The much awaited resumption of the high-speed passenger ferry service between Nagapattinam in Tamil Nadu and Kankesanthurai in Sri Lanka's Northern Province will begin on October 10 after a gap of nearly four decades.



- ✓ Official sources said the High-Speed Craft (HSC) Cheriapani, owned by the Shipping Corporation of India (SCI), and a 14member crew arrived at Nagapattinam on Saturday.

➤ **Protected Agricultural Zone - Mayiladuthurai**

- ✓ The Tamil Nadu Assembly on Wednesday adopted a Bill to make the newly formed Mayiladuthurai district a protected agricultural zone.



- ✓ The government had enacted the Tamil Nadu Protected Agricultural Zone Development Act, 2020, to convert Thanjavur, Nagapattinam and Tiruvarur districts and a few blocks of Pudukottai and Cuddalore districts into a protected agricultural zone.

### ➤ **Project Nilgiri Tahr**

- ✓ Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on Thursday launched 'Project Nilgiri Tahr' to promote the conservation of Tamil Nadu's State animal.
- ✓ He also distributed books to school students to create awareness about the Nilgiri Tahr.



- ✓ The project, with an outlay of 25 crore, aims to facilitate a better understanding of the Nilgiri Tahr population, their distribution and ecology.
- ✓ Reintroducing the animals to their historic habitats, addressing proximate threats to them, increasing public awareness on the species, and developing ecotourism at select sites are among the other aims.

### ➤ **First AI-based Early Warning System - Elephant**

- ✓ Tamil Nadu is close to completing its first artificial intelligence (AI)-based early warning system designed to protect wild elephants from train collisions along the Ettimadai-Walayar railway section.



- ✓ This initiative involves the installation of 12 e-surveillance towers equipped with thermal imaging cameras to monitor elephant movements.
- ✓ Speeding trains had hit elephants in the Madukkarai forest range in Walayar leading to the death of several wild tuskers.

➤ **Geographical Identification Tag (GI Tag)**

- ✓ Three more products from Tamil Nadu have got the coveted Geographical Identification tag (GI tag), taking the state to the top spot with 58 GI-tagged items in the country.



- ✓ 'Matti' banana native of Kanyakumari, Jaderi Namakatti from Tiruvannamalai that adorns the foreheads of deities and Vaishnavites and Chedibutta cotton sarees from Tirunelveli have got the GI tags.
- ✓ The state government authorities and traders opined that in the wake of GI tag certification, the selling price of these 3 products will increase and the livelihood of the manufacturers, weavers and farmers who produce them will also increase.
- ✓ Separate legal protection is available for these products and they will get global approval to sell these products in various countries.

➤ **'Smart District' Project**

- ✓ The UK and Tamil Nadu are collaborating on a smart tech project aimed at sustainable water, waste, and resource management.



- ✓ The project, named 'Smart District Administration using IoT Technologies for Better Quality of Life,' was chosen as part of the Frontier Technology Livestreaming (FTL) program.
- ✓ The UK-supported 'Smart District' project has a goal of tackling global sustainability challenges by deploying sensors throughout the district.
- ✓ These sensors will analyse data patterns, aiding informed decision-making for efficient resource allocation.

#### ➤ **Draft Poll Rolls**

- ✓ Draft Poll Rolls Put Number of T.N. Voters at 6.11 crore.
- ✓ The Sholinganallur Assembly constituency in Chengalpattu has the highest number of voters in the State with 6,52,065, whereas Kivelur in Nagapattinam district has the lowest with 1,69,030.



- ✓ The Sholinganallur Assembly constituency in Chengalpattu district has the highest number of voters in the State with 6,52,065, including 3,25,279 women and 110 from the third gender.
- ✓ Kivelur in Nagapattinam district has the lowest number of voters with 1,69,030, including 85,591 women and three of the third gender.

## ➤ All India Police Science Congress

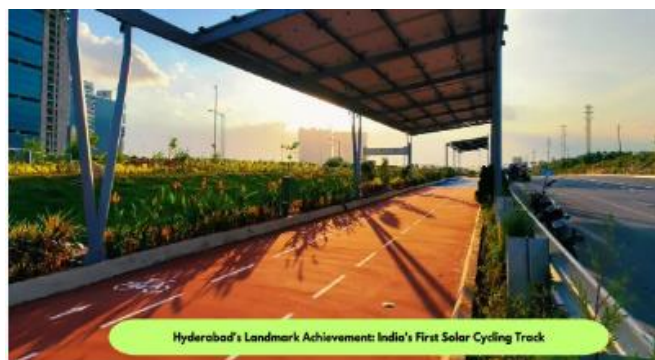
- ✓ The 49th All India Police Science Congress (AIPSC) organized by the Uttarakhand Police commenced today, October 7th at the Forest Research Institute in Dehradun.



- ✓ With the theme of “Policing in Amrit Kaal,” this annual event, held under the auspices of the Bureau of Police Research and Development (BPR&D), promises to be a platform for insightful discussions on various aspects of modern policing.
- ✓ The 49th AIPSC selected six compelling themes for discussion, each addressing vital challenges and developments in contemporary policing.
- ✓ The 49th AIPSC is embracing technology for its management, showcasing its forward-thinking approach.

## ➤ Hyderabad’s Landmark Achievement: India’s First Solar Cycling Track

- ✓ Hyderabad, India, proudly inaugurated its first solar roof cycling track, Healthway in a stride towards promoting eco-friendly and active mobility.



- ✓ Healthway aims to encourage cycling as a means of transportation while incorporating sustainability and technological innovation.



- ✓ The 23-kilometer-long Healthway cycling track comprises two distinct stretches: a pink line spanning 8.5 kilometers from Nanakramguda to the Telangana State Police Academy and a blue line stretching 14.5 kilometers from Kollur to Narsingi.
  - ✓ It boasts five different access points, making it convenient for cyclists across the city.
- **UP - Declares Gangetic Dolphin As State Aquatic Animal**
- ✓ **Uttar Pradesh** Chief Minister **Yogi Adityanath** has made a significant announcement regarding the **Gangetic Dolphin**, designating it as the state's aquatic animal.



- ✓ This move highlights the importance of conserving these unique creatures and preserving the purity of the rivers and ponds they inhabit.
  - ✓ Uttar Pradesh's decision to declare the Gangetic Dolphin as the state aquatic animal and the launch of the "**Meri Ganga Meri Dolphin 2023**" **campaign** demonstrate the government's commitment to wildlife conservation, environmental preservation, and raising awareness about the importance of maintaining the purity of rivers and ponds.
- **India's First Wetland City**
- ✓ The Rajasthan government, in collaboration with the Environment and Forest Department, is making concerted efforts to elevate Udaipur, also known as the 'City of Lakes,' to international prominence by aiming to become India's first wetland city.



- ✓ Udaipur, with its striking natural beauty and ecological significance, is poised to fulfill all the requirements stipulated by the Ramsar Convention. Covering an area of 37 square kilometers, the city is graced by five major lakes – Pichola, Fateh Sagar, Rang Sagar, Swaroop Sagar, and Doodh Talai.
- ✓ The Ramsar Convention, officially known as the Ramsar Convention on Wetlands of International Importance Especially as Waterfowl Habitat, is a global treaty designed to protect and sustainably utilize wetlands of international importance.
- **'Juhi' Mascot - Women's Asian Champions Trophy 2023**
- ✓ In a vibrant ceremony at Project Bhawan in Dhurva, Ranchi, Jharkhand, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Jharkhand, Hemant Soren, unveiled the mascot for the upcoming Women's Asian Hockey Champions Trophy 2023.



- ✓ 'Juhi,' the mascot, takes inspiration from the beloved elephant at Betla National Park.
- ✓ The event also marked the initiation of the Trophy Tour for the Jharkhand Women's Asian Champions Trophy Ranchi 2023.
- **Jharkhand 1<sup>st</sup> State To Ensure Minimum Wages**
- ✓ Jharkhand is making history by becoming the first state in India to take steps towards including gig workers, such as Swiggy, Zomato, Ola, Uber, and Rapido employees, under the ambit of minimum wages.



- ✓ This step marks a significant stride towards ensuring **equitable remuneration** for individuals operating within the gig economy.
- ✓ Jharkhand's pioneering move not only extends to the **consideration of minimum wages for gig workers** but also involves a review of the minimum wage standards for workers in various other sectors, underscoring the state's commitment to local employment and social equity.
- ✓ To address this crucial matter, the **Jharkhand State Minimum Wage Advisory Council**, operating under the state's labor department, has established a committee.
- **India's First Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS)**
- ✓ Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi is set to inaugurate the priority section of the **Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) Corridor** and simultaneously launch the **RapidX train**, symbolizing the beginning of RRTS operations in India.



- ✓ The event will take place at the Sahibabad RapidX Station in **Uttar Pradesh** on October 20, 2023.
- ✓ The priority section of the Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut RRTS Corridor, spanning **17 kilometers**, is a significant development in India's transportation infrastructure.
- ✓ With a **remarkable design speed of 180 kilometers per hour**, RRTS aims to provide high-speed trains for intercity commuting every 15 minutes.

### ➤ Graphene Production Facility

- ✓ Kerala government has announced a project to establish a graphene production facility, a first-of-its-kind initiative in India.



- ✓ Graphene is a nanomaterial with extraordinary properties and potential applications in various sectors.
- ✓ The facility will operate on a public-private partnership model, with an estimated investment of 237 crore.
- ✓ The project aims to create a graphene ecosystem in the state, fostering innovation and research in material technology.

### ➤ First State With Hallmarking Centers In Every District

- ✓ Kerala, the southern state of India, has achieved a remarkable milestone by inaugurating a hallmarking centre in Idukki.
- ✓ This achievement has solidified Kerala's position as the first state in India to establish hallmarking centres in all of its 14 districts.



- ✓ The Bureau of Indian Standards mandated the practice of hallmarking with the primary goal of protecting consumers.
- ✓ Hallmarking serves as a vital tool in ensuring the accurate determination and official recording of the proportionate content of precious metal in jewelry, artifacts, bullion, and coins.

# NATIONAL

## ➤ Expedition 'Yashasvini'

- ✓ CRPF launches all-female bikers' expedition 'Yashasvini' from Srinagar.
- ✓ The Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) is India's largest paramilitary force with over 3 lakh personnel.



- ✓ The CRPF initiated a cross-country bike rally by its women personnel named 'Yashasvini' to promote women's empowerment and gender equality.
- ✓ The rally was flagged off by the Lieutenant Governor of Jammu and Kashmir, on October 4th, 2023.
- ✓ The rally will cover a distance of 2134 kilometers.
- ✓ The rally is a collaborative effort between the CRPF and the Ministry of Women and Child Development, and aims to showcase the achievements and potential of women in various fields.

## ➤ 'Namo Bharat'

- ✓ Previously known as RapidX, country's first semi-high-speed regional rail service, Namo Bharat marks the introduction of the Regional Rapid Train Service (RRTS) in India.



- ✓ These trains are designed with the utmost passenger convenience and safety in mind.
- ✓ The Namo Bharat trains will offer a remarkable average speed of 100 kilometers per hour, outperforming both traditional metro trains and passenger trains in the Indian Railways network.
- ✓ These state-of-the-art train sets have been manufactured by Alstom, a renowned company, right here in Gujarat, further bolstering India's 'Make in India' initiative.

➤ **Project Udbhav**

- ✓ Raksha Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh launched 'Project UDBHAV', during the inauguration of the Indian Military Heritage Festival, in presence of General Manoj Pande, Chief of the Army Staff, Air Chief Marshal VR Chaudhari.



- ✓ Project UDBHAV, a collaboration between the Indian Army and the USI, is an endeavour to revisit the roots of India's ancient military thoughts.
- ✓ 'Udbhav', which translates to 'origin' or 'genesis', acknowledges the vintage scriptures and writings of our Nation, that span centuries in the past and contain profound knowledge that can benefit modern military strategies.
- ✓ The two-day festival aims to celebrate India's rich military culture and heritage, through conversations, art, dance, drama, storytelling, and exhibitions.

➤ **Bharat Tex 2024**

- ✓ India is set to host the upcoming Bharat Tex 2024 Expo, scheduled to take place from February 26-29, next year.
- ✓ The event will showcase India's capabilities as a reliable supplier of textile products, spanning the entire value chain, all under one roof.



- ✓ With an exhibition area spread across 2,00,000 square meters, Bharat Tex 2024 Expo has been conceived as the largest textile fair in the world in terms of exhibition area.
- ✓ Minister Goyal emphasized that it would provide a platform for weavers, craftsmen, and the handloom sector to showcase their skills and what's possible on a global stage.
- **NCERT To Replace 'India' With 'Bharat'**
- ✓ In a significant move, the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) has given its approval to replace the term "India" with "Bharat" in all textbooks across the country.



- ✓ One of the most talked-about proposals is to replace the name 'India' with 'Bharat' in textbooks.
- ✓ This change is expected to reflect the traditional and indigenous name for the country.
- ✓ The idea behind this recommendation is to emphasize the historical and cultural significance of the name 'Bharat' while acknowledging the nation's rich heritage.
- ✓ The committee has also suggested a shift from 'ancient history' to classical history' in the curriculum.

➤ **Mera Yuva Bharat**

- ✓ Prime Minister Narendra Modi will launch the 'Mera Yuva Bharat' platform on 31 October, which is the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel.



- ✓ The 'Mera Yuva Bharat' platform will provide a new opportunity for youths to play an active role in various nation-building events. It is a unique platform to integrate the youth power of India in building a developed India.
- ✓ It will help in developing leadership skills among youth to make them social innovators and leaders in the communities.
- ✓ The youth in the age group of 15 to 29 years will get the benefits of this platform. Mera Yuva Bharat's website My Bharat will be also launched very soon.



# COURT VERDICT

- **Supreme Court Declines - Same-Sex Marriages**
- ✓ A five-judge Constitution Bench, led by Chief Justice of India D Y Chandrachud, issued a unanimous verdict declining to recognize same-sex marriages and civil unions for non-heterosexual couples.



- ✓ All five judges on the Bench, including the CJI, agreed that there is no fundamental right to marry under the Indian Constitution.
- ✓ Interpretation of the Special Marriage Act, 1954 to allow same-sex marriage using gender-neutral language was deemed unfeasible.

# SCHEMES

## ➤ GST Amnesty Scheme 2023

- ✓ The **Goods and Services Tax (GST) Council**, in its **52nd meeting** has announced an **amnesty plan** to streamline the process of appealing against demand orders issued by tax inspectors.



- ✓ Under the existing GST rules, an individual has a **three-month window** from the date of issuance of an assessment order to file an appeal against it. This period can be extended by one additional month.
- ✓ To avail of this extended appeal period, taxpayers will be required to make an increased pre-deposit. Previously set at 10 percent of the tax demand, the pre-deposit has now been raised to **12.5 percent**. This change ensures that taxpayers have a vested interest in their appeals while providing some financial flexibility.
- ✓ This move reflects the Council's commitment to making the GST system more taxpayer-friendly.

## ➤ Establishment Of National Turmeric Board

- ✓ The Union government of India has notified the constitution of the national turmeric board, which will focus on the development and growth of turmeric and turmeric products in the country.



- ✓ The board will help in setting up processing units and aid in its export. The board will lay stress on exports, R&D and develop traditional value-added turmeric products, while also giving importance to quality and food safety as per established standards.
- ✓ India is the largest producer, consumer and exporter of turmeric in the world. It enjoys 62 per cent share in the global turmeric market.

### ➤ **Shreshta Scheme**

- ✓ Government Introduces Shreshta Scheme For Quality Education Of Scheduled Caste Students.



- ✓ In a remarkable move towards enhancing education and bolstering the socio-economic advancement of Scheduled Caste (SC) students, the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment has unveiled the 'Scheme for Residential Education for Students in High Schools in Targeted Areas' (SHRESHTA).
- ✓ SHRESHTA, designed to provide high-quality education to SC students, aims to create an environment conducive to their holistic development and secure their future prospects.

### ➤ **Samadhan Scheme**

- ✓ The Tamil Nadu government on Tuesday announced a new Samadhan scheme with waivers and concessions to pave the way for the settlement of the pending tax dues of about 25,000 crore, of which a majority are under the erstwhile Tamil Nadu Value Added Tax and other legacy tax legislations.



- ✓ The new Samadhan scheme, which was announced by the Tamil Nadu Chief Minister MK Stalin at the State Assembly, seeks to put an end to the pending tax arrears, disputes and appeals between the traders and the State commercial tax department.
- ✓ The latest Samadhan scheme seeks to put an end to the pending tax arrears, disputes and appeals between the traders and the State commercial tax department.
- **Kasanoi Erappila Thittam (KET) - KET scheme**
- ✓ The Tamil Nadu government has prioritised the nutritional status of patients diagnosed with tuberculosis (TB) and identified as severely ill and undernourished.



- ✓ In an initiative of its own, the State TB Cell has roped in volunteers to provide food baskets containing a recommended portion of high-protein food, and in the past year, has reached out to 38,235 patients across the State.
- ✓ Under the scheme, the Tamil Nadu Kasanoi Erappila Thittam (TNKET), the wellbeing of patients is assessed at the point of diagnosis.
- ✓ Those with very severe undernutrition or respiratory insufficiency or poor performance status (unable to stand without support) are prioritised for a comprehensive assessment and inpatient care.

# INTERNATIONAL

## ➤ Tallest Statue Of B.R. Ambedkar

- ✓ The tallest statue of the 'Architect of the Indian Constitution,' B.R. Ambedkar, known as the 'Statue of Equality,' is set to be unveiled in Maryland on October 14.



- ✓ The memorial symbolizes the enduring ideals of equality and human rights, reflecting the core principles that Dr. B.R. Ambedkar stood for throughout his life.
- ✓ Standing at a towering height of 19 feet, the 'Statue of Equality' is a testament to the enduring impact of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's work.
- ✓ This monumental sculpture is poised to become the largest statue of Babasaheb outside of India.

## ➤ 5th Meeting Of Moscow Format

- ✓ India Participates In The 5th Meeting Of Moscow Format.
- ✓ In a significant diplomatic gathering held in the Russian City of Kazan, representatives from various countries convened for the fifth meeting of the Moscow Format Consultation on Afghanistan.



- ✓ The primary focus of this high-level meeting was to discuss the ongoing situation in Afghanistan, with an emphasis on regional security and the integration of Afghanistan into border regional economic processes.

- ✓ One of the key outcomes of the meeting was a collective call on the Taliban to establish a government system that is “truly inclusive” and represents the interests of all key ethnopolitical groups within the country.

➤ **Operation Al-Aqsa Flood**

- ✓ The Israel-Palestine conflict has escalated dramatically as Hamas, the armed Palestinian group, initiated “Operation Al-Aqsa Flood,” firing over 5,000 rockets into Israel.



- ✓ The situation quickly escalated into a full-scale war, resulting in significant casualties and widespread fear among civilians.
  - ✓ Hamas launched a massive rocket barrage with more than 5,000 rockets targeting Israel.
- **Dakar Declaration on Climate Change 2023**
- ✓ Ministers from the world’s 46 least developed countries (LDCs) recently released the Joint Dakar Declaration on Climate Change 2023.



- ✓ The Dakar 2023 Joint Declaration on Climate Change outlines the expectations and priorities of the least developed countries for the 28th Conference of the Parties (COP28) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.
- ✓ IPCC AR6 conclusions: Ministers highlighted the conclusions of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change’s Sixth Assessment Report Cycle (IPCC AR6) summary report, which shows that global greenhouse gas (GHG)

emissions have continued to increase and global warming is fast approaching 1.5°C.

➤ **Operation Iron Swords**

- ✓ Israel Defense Forces (IDF) on Saturday launched Operation 'Iron Swords' In response to the barrages of rockets launched by Hamas from Gaza at Israel, the IDF is currently striking Hamas targets in Gaza".



- ✓ Operation Iron Swords is Israel's retaliation for a surprise attack by Hamas, a Palestinian Islamist militant organisation, on Israel.
- **First Country To Fire An Electromagnetic Railgun**
- ✓ Japan successfully tested a maritime **electromagnetic railgun** from an offshore platform on October 17, marking a significant milestone in cooperation with the **Acquisition Technology & Logistics Agency (ATLA)** and the **Japanese Maritime Self-Defense Force (JMSDF)**.



- ✓ This is the first time a country has fired a railgun from an offshore platform, which represents a significant breakthrough in defence technology.
- ✓ With the ability to fire projectiles at extremely high speeds, railguns provide a means of defending against aerial threats at sea, such as **hypersonic missiles**.
- ✓ Japan's quest for this technology is indicative of its dedication to technological advancement and strengthening its defence capacities.

- **Sri Lanka announces Free Visas**
- ✓ **Sri Lanka** waived the **visa fees for Indians and tourists from six other countries**, as part of its efforts to boost tourist arrivals and help rebuild the island nation's battered economy following last year's financial crash.



- ✓ India has remained Sri Lanka's top source market for many years. This year, over 2 lakh Indian tourists – constituting 20 percent of the total tourist arrivals – have visited the island nation until September.
- ✓ As part of its decisions, the Cabinet announced the implementation of a pilot project to issue free tourist visas to tourists from **China, India, Russia, Thailand, Indonesia, Malaysia, and Japan until March 31, 2024.**



# INDIA & OTHER COUNTRIES

## ➤ Social Security Agreement

- ✓ India and Bangladesh commenced the 11th edition of annual joint military exercise, SAMPRITI on 03rd October 2023 in Umroi, Meghalaya.



- ✓ The exercise underscores the importance of enhancing interoperability between the two armies, sharing tactical drills, and promoting best practices.

- ✓ SAMPRITI-XI, scheduled for 14 days, will engage approximately 350 personnel from both sides.
- ✓ Centered on the conduct of Sub-Conventional Operations as per Chapter VII of the UN mandate, SAMPRITI-XI will include a Command Post Exercise (CPX) and a Field Training Exercise (FTX), culminating in a Validation Exercise.
- **Annual Joint HADR Exercise 2023 (AJHE-23) - CHAKRAVAT 2023**
- ✓ AJHE, known as CHAKRAVAT, is a significant initiative that has evolved since its inception in 2015 into a multi-agency endeavour that includes the active participation of India's armed forces, paramilitary forces, disaster response organizations, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), academic institutions, and international organizations.



- ✓ The Annual Joint HADR Exercise is conducted on a rotational basis by India's three armed services: the Indian Army, Indian Navy (IN), and Indian Air Force (IAF).
- ✓ On October 11, 2023, a Multi-Agency Capability Demonstration will take place. This segment will showcase rescue and relief drills, emphasizing the nuances and important lessons learned in disaster response.
- **First Ever Mobile Tower Installed At Siachen Glacier**
- ✓ The Siachen Glacier, known as the world's highest battlefield, has witnessed a groundbreaking development with the installation of a mobile tower.



- ✓ The Fire and Fury Corps of the Indian Army, in collaboration with Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL), achieved this remarkable feat, bringing enhanced mobile communication to soldiers deployed at elevations exceeding 15,500 feet.
  - ✓ The “Siachen Warriors” in partnership with BSNL erected the first-ever BSNL Base Transceiver Station (BTS) at forward posts in the Siachen Glacier region.
- **Third Guided Missile Destroyer - Imphal**
- ✓ In a significant development for the Indian Navy, the state-of-the-art stealth guided missile destroyer, Yard 12706 (Imphal), has been officially transferred to Indian Navy on October 20, 2023.



- ✓ Imphal is the third vessel of Project 15B that was built at Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL).
- ✓ The Project is a follow-on of the Kolkata class (Project 15A) destroyers commissioned in the last decade.
- ✓ With a displacement of 7,400 tons and an overall length of 164 meters, this guided missile destroyer boasts advanced weaponry and cutting-edge sensors, including surface-to-air missiles and torpedoes.

➤ **EX. HARIMAU SHAKTI**

- ✓ Joint bilateral training Exercise Harimau Shakti 2023, between Indian & Malaysian Army commenced in Umroi Cantonment, India.



- ✓ The Malaysian Army contingent comprises troops from 5th Royal Battalion.
- ✓ The Indian contingent is being represented by the Rajput Regiment.
- ✓ 120 personnel from both sides will participate for enhancing military capability in Multi Domain and Sub-Conventional Operations.

➤ **EU And India Conduct Maiden Joint Naval Exercise**

- ✓ In a significant display of international cooperation, **India and the European Union (EU)** recently carried out their **first** joint naval exercise in the **Gulf of Guinea**, aimed at strengthening maritime security in the region.

- ✓ In September 2023, India's Gross Goods and Services Tax (GST) revenues witnessed a significant slowdown, growing at the slowest pace in 27 months.



- ✓ The growth rate dropped to 10.2% from the previous months' approximately 10.8%. This decline, although notable, was coupled with some intriguing state-wise variations in GST collections.
  - ✓ Components of GST included Central GST (CGST) collections of 29,818 crore, State GST (SGST) of 37,657 crore, and Integrated GST (IGST) of 83,623 crore. GST compensation cess inflows were 11,613 crore, which included 881 crore collected on the import of goods.
- **India to Surpass Japan In 2030**
- ✓ India To Surpass Japan In 2030 To Become 2nd Largest Economy Of Asia, Says S&P Global.



- ✓ By 2030, India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is predicted to reach a whopping \$7.3 trillion, making it the second-largest economy in the Asia-Pacific region, just after China.
- ✓ India's GDP, when measured in United States dollars (USD), is predicted to jump from \$3.5 trillion in 2022 to \$7.3 trillion by 2030.
- ✓ This rapid expansion will make India's economy second only to China in the Asia-Pacific region.

- **“Vision India@2047: Transforming India Into A Developed Nation By 2047”**
- ✓ The Indian government is working on a comprehensive national vision plan, known as ‘Vision India@2047’, aimed at transforming the country into a developed nation by 2047.



- ✓ The plan is designed to prevent India from falling into the middle-income trap and focuses on various aspects of economic and social development.
- ✓ Niti Aayog, a government think tank, has been working on this plan for nearly two years.
- ✓ The plan envisions making India a \$30 trillion economy by 2047, a significant increase from its current economic size.

- ✓ Actor Rajkummar Rao, celebrated for his portrayal of a principled government clerk in the Hindi film "Newton," tasked with conducting elections in the Naxal-affected areas of Chhattisgarh, is set to be inducted as a National Icon by the Election Commission (EC).



- ✓ Rajkummar Rao's portrayal in "Newton" resonated with audiences and critics alike. He essayed the character of an **upright government official**, undeterred by the adversities he faced while striving to conduct a free and impartial election in the **Naxal-affected regions of Chhattisgarh**.
  - ✓ The formal induction of Rajkummar Rao as a National Icon of the EC is scheduled for October 26 (Today). Chief Election Commissioner **Rajiv Kumar** will bestow this honor upon the actor, acknowledging his outstanding contribution in promoting the significance of free and fair elections in India.
- **Sadhna Nair**
- ✓ **Air Marshal Sadhna Saxena Nair** took charge as the **Director of General Hospital Services (Armed Forces)**, becoming the first women officer to hold the prestigious post.



- ✓ After the promotional transfer of Sadhna Nair, she became the second woman officer to attain the rank of Air Marshal.

  - ✓ She has been dedicated to fostering inclusive STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) education for individuals with disabilities, particularly the hearing impaired community, through comics, games, infographics, and simulations.
- **Nobel Prize 2023 - Medicine or Physiology**
  - ✓ Katalin Karikó and Drew Weissman “for their discoveries concerning nucleoside base modifications that enabled the development of effective mRNA vaccines against COVID-19”.



- ✓ The Nobel Assembly at Karolinska Institutet has today decided to award the 2023 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine.
- ✓ The discoveries by the two Nobel Laureates were critical for developing effective mRNA vaccines against COVID-19 during the pandemic that began in early 2020.

➤ **Nobel Prize In Physics 2023**

- ✓ This year Nobel Laureates in Physics 2023, were awarded to Pierre Agostini, Ferenc Krausz and Anne L’Huillier were recognised “for experimental methods that generate attosecond pulses of light for the study of electron dynamics in matter”.



- ✓ Pierre Agostini, Ferenc Krausz and Anne L’Huillier have demonstrated a way to create extremely short pulses of light that can be used to measure the rapid processes in which electrons move or change energy.
- ✓ The Nobel Prize in Physics is awarded by the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences, Stockholm, Sweden.

➤ **Global Indian Award**

- ✓ Renowned author, philanthropist and the wife of Infosys co-founder N.R. Narayana Murthy, Sudha Murthy, was honored with the prestigious Global Indian Award by the Canada India Foundation (CIF) at a grand Indo-Canadian gala in Toronto.



- ✓ The award, which carries a value of \$50,000, is presented annually to an outstanding Indian personality who has left an indelible mark in their respective field.
- ✓ Sudha Murthy’s exceptional contributions to literature, philanthropy and her dedication to giving back to society made her a fitting recipient for this esteemed award.
- ✓ In a touching and generous gesture, Sudha Murthy donated \$50,000 award money to The Field Institute at the University of Toronto.

➤ **Nobel Peace Prize 2023**

- ✓ The Norwegian Nobel Committee has decided to award the Nobel Peace Prize for 2023 to Narges Mohammadi for her fight against the oppression of women in Iran and her fight to promote human rights and freedom for all.



- ✓ However, her brave struggle has come with tremendous personal costs. Altogether, the regime has arrested her 13 times, convicted her five times, and sentenced her to a total of 31 years in prison and 154 lashes.
- ✓ The motto adopted by the demonstrators - “Woman - Life - Freedom” - suitably expresses the dedication and work of Narges Mohammadi.

➤ **Spinoza Prize**

- ✓ Dr Joyeeta Gupta has received the Spinoza Prize.
- ✓ Dr Joyeeta Gupta is an Indian-origin professor. She has received this prize for her work in the field of climate change at a ceremony in the Netherlands.



- ✓ Spinoza Prize is the highest distinction in Dutch science. The Dutch Research Council prize is worth 1.5 million euros.
- ✓ Joyeeta Gupta is a Dutch environmental scientist. She is a professor of Environment and Development in the Global South at the University of Amsterdam.

➤ **Bal Sahitya Puraskar**

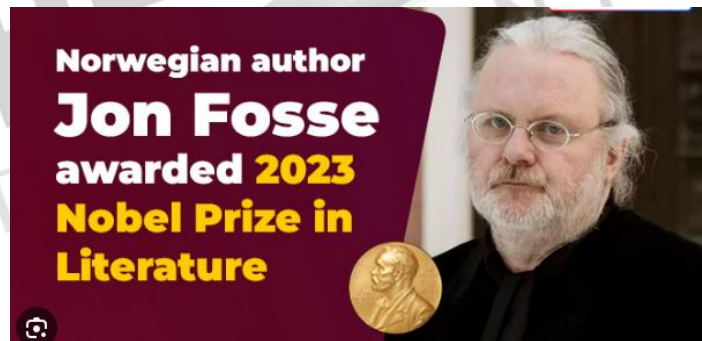

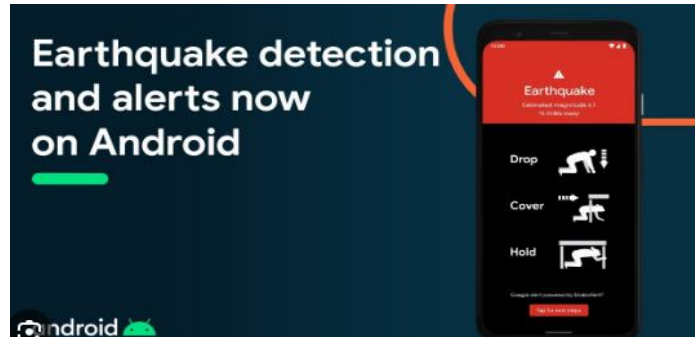


- ✓ This remarkable achievement places Messi three Ballons d'Or ahead of his rival Cristiano Ronaldo, who last won the award in 2017.

# SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY & ENVIRONMENT

## ➤ **Android Earthquake Alerts System in India**

- ✓ Search giant Google in consultation with the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) and the National Seismology Center (NSC) and the Ministry of Earth Sciences has launched its Earthquake Alerts System for Android smartphone users in India.



- ✓ The system utilizes the built-in accelerometers in Android smartphones to detect the initial stages of an earthquake.
- ✓ When multiple smartphones in a specific area detect seismic activity, the system aggregates this information to estimate the earthquake's epicentre and once the seismic event's details are determined, users in the affected area receive alerts on their smartphones.

## ➤ **Bufoides bhupathyi**

- ✓ Bufoides, is rare and endemic genus of toad found in Northeastern part of India. So far only two genus of Bufoides were known - Bufoides meghalayanus and Bufoides kempi.



- ✓ A group of scientists has discovered a new and rare species of toad in the Dampa Tiger Reserve, a forest located in the eastern Indian state of Mizoram.
- ✓ The species will be known as Bufoides bhupathyi, named after known Indian herpetologist Subramanian Bhupathy, who served as the principal scientist at the

Coimbatore (Tamil Nadu) based Salim Ali Centre for Ornithology and Natural History (SACON).

➤ **Psyche**

- ✓ NASA has launched a spacecraft called 'Psyche' on a six-year mission to study a unique metal-rich asteroid also named 'Psyche.'



- ✓ This asteroid orbits the Sun between Mars and Jupiter.
- ✓ The primary goal of the Psyche mission is to explore the iron core, a previously unexplored aspect of planet formation.

➤ **Tilapia Parvovirus**

- ✓ India's first tilapia parvovirus reported in Tamil Nadu.
- ✓ It is a small, nonenveloped, single-stranded DNA (ssDNA) virus.



- ✓ It was first reported in China in 2019 and Thailand in 2021.
- ✓ India is the third country to report the occurrence of TiPV.
- ✓ This virus was localized in the gills, heart, brain, liver, pancreas, spleen, intestine, kidney, eyes, and muscles of tilapia.

➤ **Gaganyaan TV-D1 Mission**

- ✓ In a historic moment for India's ambitious human space mission, the Test Vehicle-D1 (TV-D1), designed for the ISRO's Gaganyaan program, successfully took flight. The launch marked a significant milestone in India's space endeavours.



- ✓ The TV-D1 launch aimed to achieve several critical mission objectives. These are: 1. Flight Demonstration and Evaluation of Test Vehicle Subsystems. 2. Crew Escape System Evaluation. 3. Crew Module Characteristics Assessment and 4. Deceleration System Demonstration at Higher Altitudes.
  - ✓ The successful TV-D1 launch not only signifies India's space program but also reaffirms the nation's commitment to exploring the possibilities of human space travel.
  - ✓ As India moves closer to its goal of launching astronauts into space, this mission paves the way for a brighter future in space exploration.
- **Cyclone Hamoon**
- ✓ Cyclonic storm 'Hamoon' has intensified into a severe cyclonic storm over the northwest Bay of Bengal.



- ✓ The severe cyclonic storm is likely to hit **Bangladesh coast** and intensify further. Maximum sustained wind speed within 64 km of the cyclone centre is about 90 kph, rising to 110 kph in gusts/squalls.
  - ✓ The Cyclonic storm has been named '**Hamoon**' by **Iran**. The word 'Hamoon' is a Persian word that refers to **inland desert lakes or marshlands**.
- **Vikram-1 Rocket**
- ✓ Skyroot Aerospace unveils Vikram-1 rocket, scheduled for launch in 2024.



- ✓ **Space start-up Skyroot Aerospace** unveiled its indigenously built **Vikram-1 rocket** which is expected to deliver satellites to **low earth orbit early 2024**.
  - ✓ Science and Technology Minister Jitendra Singh also inaugurated '**The MAX-Q Campus**', the new headquarters of the start-up at the GMR Aerospace and Industrial Park at **Mamidipally in South Hyderabad**.
  - ✓ Vikram-1 is a **multi-stage** launch vehicle with a capacity to place around **300 kg of payloads in Low Earth Orbit**.
- **Ghost Particle Detector, 'Trident'**
- ✓ China is embarking on a groundbreaking endeavor by constructing an immense telescope in the western Pacific Ocean. The primary mission of this massive facility is to detect elusive particles known as "ghost particles" or neutrinos.



- ✓ This ambitious undertaking will result in the world's largest neutrino-detecting telescope.
- ✓ Neutrinos are a type of electron but, like neutrons, they do not have any charge. They are among the most abundant particles in our universe.
- ✓ With trillions of neutrinos passing through at any given second, they are also among the tiniest.
- ✓ Neutrinos were long believed to be massless, until scientists found evidence that they do have a very small mass.
- **Candolleomyces albosquamosus**
- ✓ Researchers at the Jawaharlal Nehru Tropical Botanic Garden and Research Institute (JNTBGRI) in Kerala, India, have identified a new species of mushroom, named *Candolleomyces albosquamosus*, found on the JNTBGRI campus in the Western Ghats.



- ✓ The new species belongs to the genus **Candolleomyces**, a small genus with only 35 recognized species globally.
- ✓ **Candolleomyces albosquamosus** is characterized by its delicate appearance and honey-yellow cap.
- ✓ The mushroom has a bell-shaped cap with white woolly scale-like structures, giving it a unique appearance.

- ✓ One of the experts of the research and education in the folklore sector of the State, and the entire north-eastern region, he was a source of inspiration as well as knowledge.

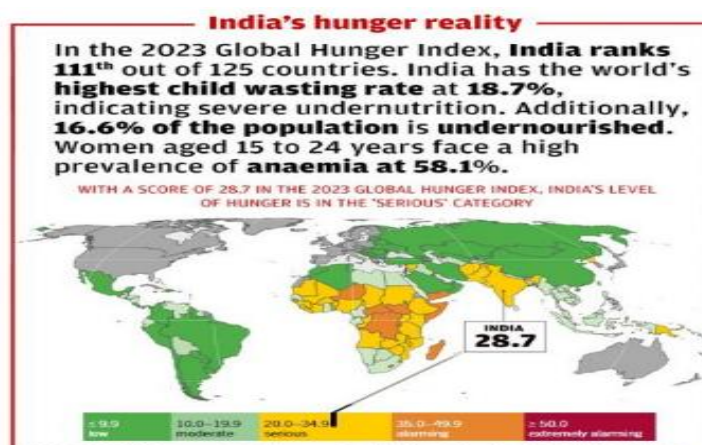

## ➤ Global Hunger Index 2023: India's Decline to 111th Place

- ✓ In the latest Global Hunger Index (GHI) for 2023, India has been ranked 111 out of 125 countries, marking a decline from its 107th position in 2022.
- ✓ The GHI is an annual assessment of hunger levels globally, published by Irish NGO Concern Worldwide and German NGO Welt Hunger Hilfe.



- ✓ Belarus, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Chile, China and Croatia are the top five countries in GHI 2023. Chad, Niger, Lesotho, Congo, Yemen, Madagascar, and Central African Republic are the countries ranked at the bottom of the index.
  - ✓ In comparison to neighboring countries, India's GHI ranking appears stark:
    - ✓ India: 111th
    - ✓ Pakistan: 102nd
    - ✓ Bangladesh: 81st
    - ✓ Nepal: 69th
    - ✓ Sri Lanka: 60<sup>th</sup>
- **Global Remote Work Index**
- ✓ In a significant shift in the global remote work landscape, India has been ranked 64th out of 108 countries in the Global Remote Work Index (GRWI).



- ✓ This marks a substantial decline of 15 places from the previous year, raising concerns about the country's readiness for remote work.
  - ✓ India's remote work challenges are largely rooted in subpar digital and physical infrastructure.
  - ✓ The nation ranked 77th in this category, indicating that its e-infrastructure is among the least developed globally (95th position).
- **Global Pension Index 2023**
- ✓ The 15th annual Mercer CFA Institute Global Pension Index (MCGPI) recently revealed the ranking of retirement income systems in various countries.
  - ✓ The Netherlands secured the top position, followed by Iceland and Denmark. India showed improvement, moving up to the 45th rank out of 47 systems analyzed.



- ✓ Netherlands on Top: The Netherlands had the highest overall index value (85.0), making it the best in the world. Iceland and Denmark: Iceland (83.5) and Denmark (81.3) claimed the second and third positions in the ranking, respectively. Argentina at the Bottom: Argentina had the lowest index value (42.3).  
India ranked 45th out of 47 countries.
