## > IMF Raises India's GDP Growth Projection to 6.8\%

$\checkmark$ The International Monetary Fund, raised India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth projection to 6.8\% for the financial year (FY) 2024-25.

$\checkmark$ In its update to the World Economic Outlook, the IMF has raised 30 basis points from its January forecast of $6.5 \%$.
$\checkmark$ In its report, the IMF said that growth in India is projected to remain strong at 6.8\% in FY 2024-25, and $6.5 \%$ in FY 2025-26 with the robustness reflecting continuing strength in domestic demand and a rising working-age population.
