### NATIONAL

- 'One nation, one election' Bill cleared by Union Cabinet
- The Union Cabinet has cleared the proposal for simultaneous Lok Sabha and state assembly elections, based on a report led by ex-president Ram Nath Kovind.



- ✓ The bill is expected to be introduced in the upcoming winter session of Parliament.
- ✓ The report suggests 18 constitutional amendments, moving towards synchronized elections for Lok Sabha, state assemblies, and later local bodies.

## **CONFERENCES & SUMMITS**

- Fourth Quad Leaders' Summit In US
- ✓ Prime Minister Narendra Modi will be on a visit to the US from 21st to 23rd September. He will take part in the fourth Quad Leaders' Summit in Wilmington, Delaware, on 21st September.



- ✓ Following the request by the US to host this year's Summit, India has agreed to host the next Quad Summit in 2025.
- Mr. Modi will address the 'Summit of the Future' at the UN General Assembly in New York on the 23rd of September.
- $\checkmark$  The theme of the summit is 'Multilateral Solutions for a Better Tomorrow'.

#### > Exercise AIKYA'

A two-day national symposium of the National Disaster Management Authority and the Army Southern Command entitled Exercise AIKYA will begin in Chennai.



- Primary aim of the exercise is to enhance disaster preparedness and foster robust collaboration among key stakeholders.


