Anguiculus dicaprioi

 A new snake species has been identified in the Western Himalayas. Scientists named it Anguiculus dicaprioi.



- The species honors actor and environmentalist Leonardo DiCaprio for his wildlife conservation efforts.
- Anguiculus dicaprioi belongs to the Colubridae family. This is the largest snake family, consisting of 304 genera and 1,938 species. Colubridae make up nearly two-thirds of all living snake species worldwide.
- The name Anguiculus translates to 'small snake' in Latin, reflecting the species' small size.
