## > ISRO And ASA Join Hands For Gaganyaan Mission

 Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has entered into a significant collaboration with the Australian Space Agency (ASA) to support India's first crewed spaceflight program, Gaganyaan.



- Two space agencies signed an Implementation Agreement (IA) to enhance cooperation on crew and crew module recovery, which is crucial for the success of the Gaganyaan mission.
- This agreement will provide India with the necessary assistance to ensure the safe recovery of astronauts in the event of a contingency during the mission.

- > India Conducts 'Historic' Flight Test of Hypersonic Missile
- ✓ India on Sunday announced the successful flight test of its maiden long-range hypersonic missile with a range of 1,500 km.

DRDO conducts historic flight trial of long-range hypersonic missile

- ✓ The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) conducted the flight test late on Saturday from Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Island, off Odisha coast, the latest in a series of missile tests in the past two months.
- The missile is designed to carry various payloads for ranges greater than 1,500 km for all the services of Indian armed forces.
