- Indian Army AI Incubation Centre (IAAIIC)
- The Indian Army has launched the Indian Army AI Incubation Centre (IAAIIC) in Bengaluru, marking a significant leap towards modernizing its operations and enhancing its technological capabilities.



- ✓ In a virtual inauguration led by Chief of Army Staff (COAS) General Upendra Dwivedi, the initiative aims to revolutionize the Army's operational capabilities through Artificial Intelligence (AI).
- The centre will focus on developing AI-driven solutions to improve decisionmaking, operational efficiency, and readiness for AI-driven warfare.

- Ravichandran Ashwin Retires from International Cricket
- One of the all-time greats of India, Ravichandran Ashwin, has announced his retirement from all forms of international cricket.



- ✓ The unexpected retirement announcement came after the third test of the 2024-25 Border Gavaskar Trophy in Brisbane ended in a draw.
- ✓ With 765 wickets in his credit, Ashwin is the second-highest wicket-taker from India after Anil Kumble.
- ✓ Ashwin has taken 537 wickets at an average of 24 in 106 Test matches. He is also 7th on the overall list of wicket-takers.
