TAMIL NADU

- Chief Minister's Pharmacies
- ✓ The Tamilnadu State government plans to open 1,000 Mudhalvar Marunthagam (Chief Minister's Pharmacies) across the State by the end of this month.



- ✓ The initiative aims at providing medicines at prices lower than those offered at cooperative, Amma, and Pradhan Mantri Jan Aushadhi pharmacies.
- ✓ These pharmacies will offer 186 varieties of generic medicines, along with Siddha, Ayurveda, Unani, IMCAPS, DAMCAL, surgical, and nutraceutical products.
- ✓ The Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation (TNMSC) will procure the quality medicines and sell them at a 10% discount price compared to other government pharmacies.

- > India is ranked 5th in the Global Economy Ranking
- ✓ NITI Aayog has said that India is ranked 5th among the world's top economies, and its real gross domestic product (GDP) will be \$4.3 trillion by 2025.



- ✓ Niti Aayog, citing the International Monetary Fund, said India's real GDP is on track to grow signicantly, rising from \$2.4 trillion in 2015 to \$4.3 trillion in 2025.
- ✓ The highest inflation-adjusted growth of 77% among the top 20 countries was also recorded by India, surpassing major economies like China and the United States.

- ✓ The day is celebrated to remember the discovery of the "Raman Effect" by Sir C V Raman on 28 February 1928.
- ✓ The theme of National Science Day 2025 is "Empowering Indian Youth for Global Leadership in Science & Innovation for VIKSIT BHARAT."
- ✓ In 1986, the Government of India declared 28 February as National Science Day.
