NATIONAL

➤ India Records Over 5.5 Lakh Trademark Registrations in 2024-25

- ✓ India recorded over 5.5 lakh trademark registrations in FY 2024-25, the highest ever in a single year, reflecting stronger IP protection, streamlined processes, and growing confidence among startups, innovators, and businesses.
- ✓ The surge is attributed to digitisation of IP services, faster examination, and awareness campaigns, with the pharmaceutical, veterinary, and healthcare sectors leading filings.
- ✓ This milestone aligns with India's vision to strengthen the innovation ecosystem, boost entrepreneurship, and support economic growth through effective intellectual property frameworks under the Trade Marks Act, 1999.

➤ AI-Based Grievance Redressal System

- ✓ The Delhi Government has partnered with IIT Kanpur to develop an AI-powered Intelligent Grievance Monitoring System (IGMS). The system will integrate multiple grievance port
- ✓ als like CPGRAMS and LG Listening Post into a single unified dashboard. Using artificial intelligence and machine learning, IGMS will enable faster grievance resolution, root-cause analysis, department prediction, and greater transparency.
- ✓ The initiative strengthens citizen-centric governance, improves inter-departmental coordination, and promotes data-driven decision-making in public administration.

- **India's First Public Private Partnership (PPP) Model Medical Colleges**
- ✓ India is set to witness a major reform in medical education with the establishment of its first Public Private Partnership (PPP) model medical colleges in Madhya Pradesh.
- ✓ Madhya Pradesh has become the first state in India to operationalise medical colleges under the PPP model, particularly in tribal and backward regions.
- ✓ The PPP initiative aims to address regional imbalance in medical education and healthcare delivery.
- ✓ Under the PPP framework, the state government provides land (up to 25 acres) on lease and Private partners construct infrastructure, including college buildings, hostels, laboratories and residential facilities.
- ✓ All development and upgrades will strictly follow National Medical Commission (NMC) norms.
- ✓ Four PPP-based medical colleges are planned in the state at Dhar, Betul, Katni and Panna, all linked with district hospitals.

- **4th India AI Impact Summit in New Delhi**
- ✓ India will host the 4th Edition of the India AI Impact Summit in New Delhi from 15 to 20 February.
- ✓ The India AI Impact Summit aims to shape the future of inclusive, responsible, and resilient Artificial Intelligence (AI).
- ✓ The summit is anchored on three guiding principles, namely People, Planet, and Progress.
- ✓ These principles emphasize AI for human welfare, environmental protection, and inclusive economic growth.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

- **Indian AI Research Organisation (IAIRO)**
- ✓ Gujarat has approved the establishment of the Indian AI Research Organization (IAIRO) at GIFT City, Gandhinagar, making it the first state to set up such an institute under a PPP model.
- ✓ The IAIRO will begin operations from January 1, 2026, as a Section 8 non-profit entity, with an outlay of ₹300 crore over five years shared equally by the State Government, Central Government, and Indian Pharmaceutical Alliance (IPA).

- ✓ Aligned with the IndiaAI Mission, the institute will focus on advanced AI research, AI-based solutions, IP creation, capacity building, and developing a future-ready AI workforce, strengthening India's position in global AI innovation.

SPORTS

➤ World Police and Fire Games 2029

- ✓ Rashtriya Raksha University (RRU), Gujarat, will host eight disciplines of the World Police and Fire Games (WPFG) 2029, marking India's first time as a host nation for this prestigious international sporting event for uniformed services.
- ✓ The World Police and Fire Games is a biennial, Olympic-style sporting event exclusively for police, fire service, and law enforcement personnel from across the world.
- ✓ The Games feature more than 60 sports disciplines and attract thousands of participants globally.
- ✓ In the 2025 United States of America edition, over 9,000 athletes participated, and India won more than 600 medals, highlighting its strong performance.
