

TAMIL NADU

Barrier-free Environment - 10 Government Buildings

- ✓ The Collector's offices in Chennai and Coimbatore, and the Government College
 of Technology in Coimbatore are among the list of the 10 State government
 buildings, where barrier-free environment will be created under the Accessible
 India Campaign.
- ✓ In the State capital, the Government Museum and the Directorate of Agriculture will have barrier-free environment for the benefit of disabled persons.

English Translation of Tamil Literary Works

- ✓ Chief Minister M.K. Stalin is likely to release a set of books, including The Cilappatikaram, translated into English under the 'Taking Tamil to the World project'.
- √ 'Taking Tamil to the World' is a collaboration between Tamil Nadu Textbook and Educational Services Corporation (TNTB and ESC) and private publishers to promote the rich literary history and culture of Tamil Nadu.

State's Borrowing Less than Indicated

✓ Tamil Nadu has so far borrowed 4,400 crore in the fourth quarter of FY 2022 through issue of bonds, known as State Development Loans, which is lesser than the indicated borrowing of 9,000 crore from January 4 to Feburary 1, as per data from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).

> Aran

- ✓ Pudukottai district administration has launched an initiative called 'Aran' to help school children and adolescents open up on issues affecting their studies and mental health.
- ✓ The initiative seeks to help children and young people access information and support related to their rights, needs, safety and protection, legal assistance, mental and physical health, sexual and reproductive health.

> AquaMAP

✓ Indian Institute of Technology, Madras - is establishing a new inter-disciplinary Water Management and Policy Centre called 'AquaMAP' to solve water problems in India.

> NEET Bill

- ✓ House will create history if it re-adopts NEET Bill today.
- ✓ A history of sorts will be created on Tuesday if the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly adopts again a Bill seeking to dispense with the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET) in the State.

✓ This will be for the first time in the history of the State legislature that the House will re-adopt the same draft of the bill, which has been returned by Governor R. N. Ravi.

State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA)

- ✓ The State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) has given the nod for the first ever industrial housing project for labourers, besides the furniture park at Tuticorin.
- ✓ The industrial park along with the housing facility would come up in a span of 353 acres of land as part of the Vallam -Vadagal expansion (part-II).
- ✓ The state industries promotion corporation of Tamil Nadu would execute the industrial housing project.

Indian Institute of Technology

- Researchers at the Indian Institute of Technology, Madras have developed an artificial intelligence (AI) tool to study the processes involved in the transformation of biomass to gaseous fuel.
- ✓ The research team used a Machine Learning method called Recurrent Neural Networks (RNN) to study the reactions that occur during the conversion of lingocellulosic biomass into energy-dense syngas (gasification of biomass).

Tirukkural-Themed Calendars

- ✓ Tirukkural-themed desktop calendars by the State Tamil Development Department and the Tamil Virtual Academy are on sale.
- ✓ The desktop calendar with 365 Tirukkural themed paintings by children with month and dates could be used any year.

> T.N.'s Success in Poverty Reduction

✓ All the three editions of NITI Aayog, the Centre's policy think tank's implementation of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), have one common feature –Tamil Nadu finishing on top with regard to Goal 1 - "No Poverty."

> Keeladi - Eight Part of Excavation

- ✓ On February 11, Tamil Nadu chief minister M K Stalin inaugurated the eight part of excavation at Keeladi in Sivaganga district via video conferencing at the State Secretariat in Chennai.
- ✓ CM also launched the third part at Sivagalai in Tuticorin district and the first ever excavation at Vembakottai in Virudhunagar district, Perumbalai in Dharmapuri district and Thulukkarpatti in Tirunelveli.
- ✓ The second phase of excavations in Gangaikondacholapuram in Ariyalur district, and Mayiladumparai in Krishnagiri district were also launched during the occasion

✓ The eighth part of the excavation at Keeladi and its cluster villages of Konthagai, Manalur and Agaram would carry forward the earlier discoveries of brick constructions.

Indian Institute of Technology, Madras (IIT-M)

- On February 11, Indian Institute of Technology, Madras (IIT-M) Pravartak Technologies Foundation has partnered with Asha for Education to launch two rural technology centres in Tamil Nadu
- ✓ Under the partnership, two Asha-IIT Madras Pravartak Rural Technology Centres were inaugurated in Kanakamma Chathram and Seethanjeri villages in Tiruvallur district
- ✓ The centres, which will train students of classes 9 to 12, is being funded by IIT Madras Pravartak Technologies Foundation.

> Green Methodology

- ✓ Woman scientist granted patent for developing a green methodology.
- ✓ Dr. E. Poonguzhali, a woman scientist at IIT Madras has been granted a patent for developing a green methodology for producing a medicinally important compound called Benzo[b]thiophene.

International Epilepsy Day

- ✓ Nearly 3.94 lakh in State have epilepsy.
- ✓ An awareness programme was organised to mark the International Epilepsy Day at the Government Stanley Hospital on Monday.

> Inland Wetland Survey

- ✓ Tirunelveli records 33,000 birds of 41 species in inland wetland survey.
- ✓ After coastal wetlands, the survey for inland wetlands was done in Tamil Nadu covering 339 wetlands from 25 districts.
- ✓ This comprised of 14 inland waterbird sanctuaries including the historical waterbird sanctuary such as Vedanthangal.
- ✓ Salem hosted 97 inland wetlands which was the highest followed by Chennai with 28 wetlands.

STATE

> Happiness

- ✓ The Madhya Pradesh government is planning to introduce 'happiness' as a subject in the syllabus of its high school and higher secondary school classes from the next academic session.
- ✓ Once introduced, the State would be possibly the first state in the country where this subject will be introduced in schools.

National Single Window System (NSWS)

STUD

- ✓ Jammu & Kashmir became the first Union Territory to be integrated with the National Single Window System (NSWS).
- ✓ National Single Window System (NSWS), a 2020 budgetary announcement of the Government of India, is a digital platform that provides support to the investors in getting government approvals for projects.

India's 1st Bullet Train Station

- ✓ First glimpses of India's first Bullet Train station in Surat are finally out. The Ministry of Railways on February 10, shared the graphical representation of Surat's Bullet Train station to be constructed between Mumbai- Ahmedabad route.
- ✓ National High-Speed Rail Corporation Ltd (NHSRCL) will be constructing this project that is scheduled to be completed by December 2024.

NATIONAL

India's First Geological Park

- ✓ The first 'geological' park of country will be built at Lamheta village on the banks of river Narmada in Jabalpur district of Madhya Pradesh.
- ✓ Approval for the park has been granted by Geological Survey of India, under ministry of mining.
- ✓ Significantly, this site is already present in the tentative list of UNESCO's geoheritage for the protection of natural heritage.

> Union Budget

- ✓ Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on 1 February 2022 presented the Union budget 2022-2023.
- ✓ The government has decided to levy 30% tax, the highest tax band in the country, on income arising out of the sale of digital assets.
- Digital rupee will be issued using blockchain technology by the RBI starting 2022-23.

Budget: e-Passports

- ✓ The government will issue e-passports in the financial year 2022-23.
- The e-passport will use Radio-Frequency Identification (RFID) and biometrics to verify the identity.

✓ Budget 2022-23

- ✓ The Centre will be launching a National Tele Mental Health program.
- ✓ A record 25,000 km of National Highways will be built.
- ✓ A National Master Plan on Expressways will be formulated in 2022-23, to facilitate faster movement of people and goods.
- Around 68% of the capital procurement budget for Defence has been earmarked for domestic industry to promote Aatmanirbhar Bharat.

Union Budget - 2022-23

- ✓ On February 1, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman presented the Union Budget for 2022-23 and tabled the Finance Bill 2022 to the Parliament.
- ✓ The Union Budget focused on 4 pillars of development PM Gati Shakti, investment financing, productivity enhancement, energy transition and climate action
- ✓ During her speech, the FM announced laying the foundation for "Amrit Kaal", a new term for the 25-year period in the run-up to India at 100.

> Swachhta Saarthi Fellowship 2022

- ✓ The Office of the Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India has announced the "Swachhta Saarthi Fellowship 2022".
- ✓ It has been launched under its "Waste to Wealth" Mission.
- ✓ It will empower young innovators who are engaged in community work of waste management, waste awareness campaigns, etc. as Swachhta Saarthis and implement actions to reduce waste for a greener planet.

> Sagarmala Scheme

- ➤ The Union government has announced to develop Puducherry port in three phases at a cost of 304. 8 crore under the Sagarmala scheme to utilize it as a feeder port for Chennai port.
- ✓ As per the Union Minister, Chennai Port Trust and Puducherry Port Department signed a memorandum of understanding in March 2017 with the approval of the Union shipping ministry to utilize port in Puducherry as a feeder port to Chennai port.

Other Effective Area-Based Conservation Measures" (OECM)

- ✓ The Aravalli Biodiversity Park in Gurugram, Haryana has been declared as India's first "other effective area-based conservation measures" (OECM) site.
- ✓ This was informed by the Union ministry of environment, forest and climate change on the occasion of World Wetlands Day on February 2.

> Statue Of Equality

✓ Prime Minister Narendra Modi has inaugurated the 216-feet tall 'Statue of Equality' commemorating the 11th-century Bhakti Saint Sri Ramanujacharya and dedicated to the nation the 'Statue of Equality' in Hyderabad.

Indradhanush 4.0

- ✓ On February 7, Union health minister Mansukh Mandaviya virtually launched the Intensified Mission Indradhanush 4.0.
- ✓ The fourth round of the Universal Immunisation Programme aims to protect children and pregnant women from life-threatening diseases.
- ✓ Under this world's largest inoculation drive, annually over 3 crore pregnant women and 2.6 crore children are covered.

> Maternity Benefit Scheme

✓ The government's recent announcement that the maternity benefit programme which provides 5,000 for first child will be extended to cover the second child only if it is a girl has met with sharp criticism from activists who have demanded that it be universalised.

- ✓ The Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY), launched in 2017, provides 5,000 for the birth of the first child to partially compensate a woman for loss of wages.
- ✓ It also aims to improve the nutritional well-being of the mother and the child. The amount is given in three instalments upon meeting certain conditions. It is combined with another scheme, Janani Suraksha Yojana, under which nearly 1,000 is given for an institutional birth, so that a woman gets a total of 6,000.

> Operation AAHT

- ✓ The Railway Protection Force has launched a nationwide operation to curb human trafficking. As part of "Operation AAHT", special teams will be deployed on all long-distance trains/routes with focus on rescuing victims, particularly women and children, from the clutches of traffickers.
- ✓ The Railways, which operate about 21,000 trains across the country daily, is the
 most reliable mode of transportation for the traffickers who often move their
 victims on long-distance trains.

Nitric Oxide Nasal Spray (NONS)

- ✓ On February 9, Glenmark pharmaceuticals launched the first ever nasal spray in India to treat high-risk adult patients suffering from Covid-19.
- ✓ The high-risk patients include non-vaccinated patients, patients in the middle and older age group and patients with co-morbidities.
- ✓ The company has launched Nitric Oxide Nasal Spray (NONS), named FabiSpray, in partnership with Canadian pharmaceutical company SaNOtize Research & Development Corp.

Biomass-Based Hydrogen Plant

- ✓ India's first commercial-scale biomass-based hydrogen plant will come up at the Khandwa district of Madhya Pradesh.
- ✓ Everyday this plant will produce one tonne of hydrogen, from 30 tonnes of biomass feedstock.

Indian Railways Management Service (IRMS)

- ✓ On February 9, the Centre formally notified the unification of eight services related to Indian Railways under the Central Civil Services into the newly created Group 'A' Central service called 'Indian Railways Management Service' (IRMS).
- ✓ With the unification, railways is left with just two departments, namely the Railway Protection Force (RPF) and Medical Service Department (MSD).

Sustainable Access to Markets and Resources for Innovative Delivery of Healthcare (SAMRIDH)

✓ Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), NITI Aayog, and the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) - announced a new partnership under the Sustainable

- Access to Markets and Resources for Innovative Delivery of Healthcare (SAMRIDH) initiative.
- ✓ The tie-up seeks to improve access to affordable and quality healthcare for vulnerable populations in tier-2 and tier-3 cities, and rural and tribal regions.

> PMKSY till March 2026

- ✓ The 'Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY)' has been extended till March 2026.
- ✓ The scheme is administered by the Ministry of Food Processing Industries.
- ✓ The scheme aims for the overall growth and development of the food processing sector.

> 100th Textile Train

- ✓ The Mumbai Central Division of the Western Railway zone has achieved a milestone of operating the 100th Textile train in the country.
- ✓ The textile trains are significant for textile market of Surat region because they are economical, faster and safer mode of transport.
- > Section 69(A) of the Information Technology Act
- ✓ On February 14, the government has blocked 54 Chinese apps under Section 69(A) of the Information Technology Act over privacy, security, and espionage concerns.
- ✓ The request for blocking of apps was received from the home ministry under an emergency provision in the Information Technology Act.

➤ New Frontiers Program

- ✓ Ministry of New and Renewable Energy to host "New Frontiers" program.
- ✓ The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy is conducting a program on renewable energy namely "New Frontiers" as part of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav.
- ✓ A meeting on "Roadmap to achieve net-zero carbon emissions by 2070" will be held on 18 Feb.

SCHEMES

Mission Vatsalya

- ✓ Government implements 'Mission Vatsalya' for rehabilitation of children.
- ✓ The Ministry of Women and Child Development is implementing the Centrally sponsored 'Child Protection Services (CPS) Scheme – 'Mission Vatsalya.'
- ✓ It is for rehabilitation of children in difficult circumstances including, orphan and destitute children.

Parvatmala Scheme

- ✓ The Union Finance Minister in the Union Budget for 2022-23 announced National Ropeways Development Programme – "Parvatmala" to improve connectivity in hilly areas.
- ✓ The idea is to improve connectivity and convenience for commuters, besides promoting tourism.

> SMILE

- ✓ The Department of Social Justice and Empowerment will launch the scheme "SMILE: Support for Marginalised Individuals for Livelihood and Enterprise" on 12 February 2022.
- ✓ There are 2 sub-schemes under this 'Central Sector Scheme for Comprehensive Rehabilitation for Welfare of Transgender Persons' and 'Central Sector Scheme for Comprehensive Rehabilitation of persons engaged in the act of Begging'.

INTERNATIONAL

Quad Meet - Indo-Pacific Ties

- ✓ Calling for justice for the 26/11 terror attacks in Mumbai (2008) and the Pathankot airbase attack (2016) for the first time since the group was formed, the Foreign Ministers of Australia, India, Japan and the U.S. said the Quad was already cooperating on sharing intelligence on threats in the Indo-Pacific region.
- ✓ The group of Ministers, who held their fourth Quad Ministerial meeting in Melbourne on Friday, also resolved to speed up delivery of more than a billion COVID-19 vaccines to be manufactured in India, to hold a special meet on climate change this year, and to step up efforts to ensure maritime security in the region.

INDIA & OTHER COUNTRIES

> Indo-Pacific Strategy

- ✓ US President Joe Biden's administration released its Indo-Pacific strategy on 11 February 2022.
- ✓ It recognized India as a like-minded partner and leader in South Asia and the Indian Ocean, active in and connected to Southeast Asia.
- ✓ The document focuses on building collective capacity to deal with challenges in the region - China's assertiveness, the pandemic, and climate change, among others.

Unitary Digital Identity Framework

India - has agreed to provide a grant to Sri Lanka to implement a 'Unitary Digital Identity framework', which is similar to the Aadhaar card.

The government of Sri Lanka has decided to speed up the implementation of a Unitary Digital Identity framework in the country.

CONFERENCES & SUMMITS

Reimagining Museums Global Summit 2022

- ✓ The first-of-its-kind Global Summit -'Reimagining Museums in India' will be held on February 15-16, 2022.
- ✓ The summit aims to bring together experts from across the world to share best global practices for museum development and management, understanding the current needs of Museums in India and developing a blueprint for renewal of Indian museums.

NITI Aayog's Fintech Open Summit

- ✓ NITI Aayog, in collaboration with PhonePe, AWS and EY, has organized a three-week-long virtual summit, 'Fintech Open', from 7–28 February.
- ✓ A first-of-its-kind initiative, Fintech Open will bring together regulators, fintech
 professionals and enthusiasts, industry leaders, the start-up community, and
 developers to collaborate, exchange ideas and innovate.

> ASEAN-India High-Level Conference

- ✓ Ministry of New and Renewable Energy and Ministry of External Affairs jointly hosted the ASEAN-India High-Level Conference on Renewable Energy (RE) from February 7-8, 2022 through video conference.
- ✓ The meeting took place on the theme of "Experience and Innovations for Integrated Renewables Market".

> One Ocean Summit

- ✓ Prime Minister Narendra Modi has addressed the high-level segment of the One Ocean Summit.
- ✓ The One Ocean summit is organised by France from 9-11 February in Brest in cooperation with the United Nations and the World Bank.
- ✓ The objective of the summit is to mobilise the international community to take tangible action towards preserving and supporting healthy and sustainable ocean ecosystems.

> 4th QUAD Foreign Ministers' Meet

- ✓ On February 11, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar participated in the 4th QUAD Foreign Ministers' meet in Melbourne, Australia alongside his US, Japanese, and Australian counterparts.
- ✓ This was the third in-person meeting of Quad foreign ministers, following their meeting in Tokyo in October 2020 and the inaugural meeting in New York in September 2019.

World Sustainable Development Summit 2022

- ✓ Prime Minister Narendra Modi will deliver the inaugural address virtually at TERI's World Sustainable Development Summit on February 16, 2022.
- ✓ The World Sustainable Development Summit 2022 Theme is 'Towards a Resilient Planet: Ensuring a Sustainable and Equitable Future'.



DEFENCE

- Indian Navy's fifth Scorpene submarine "Vagir"
- ✓ Indian Navy's fifth Scorpene submarine "Vagir" begins its sea trials.
- ✓ The fifth submarine of Project 75, "Vagir" commenced its sea trials on 1 February.
- ✓ It was launched in November 2020 from the Kanhoji Angre Wet Basin of Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL).

> Konkurs-M

✓ On February 2, Bharat Dynamics Limited (BDL) and Indian Army - have signed a three-year contract for the manufacture and supply of anti-tank guided missile Konkurs-M to the Indian Army.

Konkurs-M is a second-generation, mechanised infantry anti-tank guided missile, to destroy armoured vehicles.

> Milan 2022

- ✓ US and Russia have confirmed the participation in India's biggest-ever maritime exercise 'Milan 2022' to be held from 26 February to 4 March 2022.
- ✓ A total of 46 countries have been invited, out of which over 35 have confirmed participation.
- ✓ 'Milan' is a biennial multilateral naval exercise hosted by the Indian Navy.

ECONOMY

National Land Monetisation Corporation

- ✓ Government has established National Land Monetisation Corporation (NLMC).
- ✓ NLMC has been set up to fast track monetization of land and non-core assets of public sector entities.

India's Top Trade Partner in 2021

- ✓ The United States was India's top trading partner in the calendar year 2021 with a trade of \$112.3 billion.
- ✓ The US is followed by China on second. The value of trade between India and China was \$110.4 billion.

Monetary Policy Committee (MPC)

On February 10, Reserve Bank Governor Shaktikanta Das headed six-member Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) - decided to maintain the status quo on the benchmark interest rate or repo rate at its six and final bi-monthly review meeting of FY22

> e-RUPI

- ✓ In another key decision, the cap under e-RUPI prepaid digital vouchers has been enhanced from 10,000 presently, to 1 lakh per voucher and the vouchers can be used more than once for multiple transactions until the amount is fully redeemed.
- ✓ The move, aimed at enhancing the delivery of government schemes, will also help companies offer a larger range of benefits to their employees through the vouchers.

> Financial Literacy Week

- ✓ RBI has selected "Go Digital, Go Secure" as the theme for Financial Literacy
 Week 2022.
- ✓ This theme is one of the strategic objectives of the National Strategy for Financial Education 2020-2025. RBI will focus on creating awareness about the convenience of digital transactions.

APPOINTMENT

> Lt General Manoj Pande

- ✓ On February 1, Lt General Manoj Pande took over as the new vice-chief of the Indian Army.
- Pande, comes to Army headquarters after commanding the eastern command in Kolkata.

Dinesh Prasad Saklani

- ✓ Professor Dinesh Prasad Saklani has been appointed the new director of National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) on February 4.
- ✓ Professor Saklani has been awarded with Distinguished Academy Award by Punjab Kala and Sahitya Academy, Jalandhar for Historical writing in 2005.

Santishree Dhulipudi Pandit

- ✓ Santishree Dhulipudi Pandit has become the first woman to hold the position of vice-chancellor at Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU).
- ✓ A professor of political science at the Savitribai Phule Pune University in Maharashtra since 1992, Pandit has been appointed for a period of five years.

> Sukla Mistry

✓ Sukla Mistry - has taken over as Director (Refineries) of Indian Oil and became the first woman Director on the board of Indian Oil Corporation (IOC), the nation's largest oil refining and fuel marketing company.

> Dr S Unnikrishnan Nair

- > Renowned scientist and launch vehicle specialist Dr S Unnikrishnan Nair took charge as the director of Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC) on February 7.
- ✓ VSSC is a key space research centre of the Indian Space Research Organisation (Isro) and specialises in rocket and space vehicles for satellite programs.

> S. Kishore

- ✓ Senior bureaucrat S. Kishore has been appointed as the Chairman, Staff Selection Commission (SSC).
- ✓ According to an order issued by the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT).

AWARDS

NHRC's Short Film Award

✓ A Telugu short film 'Street Student' by Akula Sandeep depicting the story of a street urchin with a strong message on right to education has bagged the first prize in a competition organised by the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC).

> Tableau of Uttar Pradesh

The tableau of Uttar Pradesh - has been selected as the best tableau among the 12 States/UTs which participated in the Republic Day parade.

✓ This was announced by the Ministry of Defence on February 4.

> Writing With Fire

✓ Indian documentary 'Writing With Fire' - has been nominated in the Best Documentary Feature category at the 94th edition of the Academy Awards.

CENTRE

✓ It is also the only Indian film to earn the nomination this year.



PERSONALITIES

Queen Elizabeth II

- ✓ Queen Elizabeth II has become the first British monarch to rule for 70 years. She surpassed Louis XIV of France as the longest-reigning monarch of a sovereign state.
- Elizabeth II is the Queen of the United Kingdom and 14 other Commonwealth realms. On 6 February 1952, Elizabeth became queen after the death of her father King George VI.

Gautam Adani

- ✓ Adani Group chairman Gautam Adani has become the richest person in India and Asia, surpassing Reliance Industries Ltd's Mukesh Ambani.
- ✓ Adani's net worth stood at \$88.5 billion on February 8 as against Ambani's \$87.9 billion, according to the Bloomberg Billionaires Index
- ✓ With this massive spike, Adani has overtaken Mukesh Ambani, to become the world's 10th richest person.

BOOKS & AUTHORS

Book Titled "Atal Bihari Vajpayee"

- ✓ A book titled "Atal Bihari Vajpayee" authored by Sagarika Ghose has been launched. It is a biography of the former Prime Minister of India.
- ✓ Sagarika Ghose is a jounalist. She has also authored a book titled "Indira: India's Most Powerful Prime Minister".

How to Prevent the Next Pandemic

- ✓ A book titled 'How to Prevent the Next Pandemic' has authored by Bill Gates will be published this year in May 2022.
- ✓ In the book Bill Gates has written about specific steps that can only stop future pandemics but, in the process, provide better health care for everyone around the world.

SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY & ENVIRONMENT

World's First Hydrogen-powered Flying Boat 'The Jet'

- ✓ Dubai firm, THE JET ZeroEmission announced the launch of the World's first hydrogen-powered flying boat 'THE JET' in Dubai, United Arab Emirates.
- √ 'THE JET' features cutting-edge characteristics and technologies, making it
 capable of flying in silence over the waters at a cruising speed of 40 knots and
 also has a capacity of carrying 8-12 passengers.

> Chandrayan-3

India - is set to launch the Chandrayan-3 in August this year.

- ✓ The ISRO has planned 19 missions that including eight launch vehicle missions, seven spacecraft missions and four technology demonstrator missions have been planned for this year.
- ✓ This year is expected to be quite busy for ISRO as major projects such as Gaganyaan and Aditya solar mission are also in the pipeline.

> Param Pravega

- ✓ The Indian Institute of Science (IISc.), Bengaluru, has installed and commissioned Param Pravega, one of the most powerful supercomputers in India.
- ✓ It is also the largest supercomputer in an Indian academic institution.

> Nanoparticle-Coated Antiviral Face Mask

- ✓ Indian scientists have developed self-disinfecting Copper-based Nanoparticle-coated Antiviral Face Mask, which is biodegradable, highly breathable and washable.
- ✓ It has been developed by scientists at International Advanced Research Centre for Powder Metallurgy and New Materials (ARCI), in collaboration with the Centre for Cellular & Molecular Biology (CSIR-CCMB) and Resil Chemicals, a Bengaluru based company.

Scomberoides Pelagicus

- ✓ The Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) has identified a new carangid (Vatta) species from the Indian coast.
- ✓ The fish, Scomberoides pelagicus, is a member of the 'queen fish' family and is locally known as 'pola vatta.'

Asteroid Terrestrial-impact Last Alert System (ATLAS)

✓ The Asteroid Terrestrial-impact Last Alert System (ATLAS) - has become the first asteroid detection system to scan entire night sky to detect hazardous asteroids moving towards the Earth ✓ The NASA-funded system is operated by the University of Hawaii's (UH) Institute for Astronomy.

Square Kilometre Array Observatory (SKAO)

- ✓ On February 2, India signed a cooperation agreement to confirm its participation in 'Square Kilometre Array Observatory' (SKAO) project
- The agreement signed to set up the world's largest radio telescope will be valid for one year.

Space Station to Retire in 2030

✓ NASA - announced plans for the International Space Station to retire in 2030 and then crash it into an uninhabited area known as 'Point Nemo' into the Pacific Ocean in 2031.

> 2DPA-1

- ✓ Researchers from Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) have developed a new two-dimensional polymer material called 2DPA-1 that is stronger than steel but light as plastic.
- ✓ The new polymer has twice the yield strength of steel and up to six times the
 deformation resistance of bulletproof glass.

> Asteroid 38971 (2001 CB21)

- ✓ A giant asteroid called 138971 (2001 CB21) is heading towards the Earth and is likely to make a close pass in March.
- ✓ It is estimated to be four times bigger than the Eiffel Tower and has been tagged as potentially hazardous, as it will come as close as 4.5 million km.

COVID-19 DNA Vaccine

- ✓ India has become the first country in the world to administer a DNA vaccine against COVID-19.
- ✓ The ZyCoV-D which is the World's first plasmid DNA vaccine has been produced by Ahmedabad-based vaccine manufacturer Zydus Cadila and it was administered for the first time in Patna.

> ISRO Launch Earth Observation Satellite

- ✓ The Indian Space Research Organisation will launch radar imaging satellite EOS-04 on February 14, 2022.
- ✓ The satellite has been designed to provide high-quality images under all weather conditions. It will be launched aboard Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV-C52) at 05:59 hours on February 14th from the First Launch Pad of Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota.

Sputnik Light Covid-19 Vaccine

- ✓ The Drugs controller General of India granted Emergency Use Permission to single dose Sputnik light Covid-19 vaccine.
- ✓ With this, it has become the ninth Covid-19 vaccine to get the approval for usage in the country
- Sputnik and Sputnik Light is based on recombinant human adenovirus vector platform.

Lactobacillus Plantarum JBC5

- ✓ Indian scientists develop a next-generation probiotic.
- ✓ A team of Indian scientists from the Institute of Advanced Study in Science and Technology (IASST), Guwahati, has identified the next-generation probiotic bacterium Lactobacillus Plantarum JBC5 from a dairy product.
- ✓ The product showed great promise in promoting healthy aging.

> NASA

- NASA has selected two science missions to help improve the understanding of the Sun-Earth connection, the dynamics of the Sun, and the constantly changing space environment.
- ✓ The two missions chosen by NASA are Multi-slit Solar Explorer (MUSE) and HelioSwarm missions, which aim at studying the sun's corona and also measuring the magnetic field of the solar wind.

➤ ISRO PSLV-C52 Satellite

✓ The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) launched the Polar Satellite
Launch Vehicle, PSLV-C52, carrying three satellites (EOS-04, a radar imaging
satellite along with its two passenger satellites, INSPIREsat-1 and INS-2TD) on
14 Feb 2022 from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota.

Polaris Dawn

- ✓ SpaceX engineer Anna Menon will be among the crew of a unique space mission announced on 14 Feb 2022 by Jared Isaacman.
- ✓ The first mission is named Polaris Dawn

Koalas as Endangered Species

- ✓ Australia has officially listed koalas as endangered species.
- ✓ Koala species are inhabited in Australia for at least 25 million years.
- ✓ At present, only one species remains the Phascolarctos cinereus.

SPORTS

World Games Athlete of the Year

- ✓ On January 31, Indian Hockey goalkeeper, P R Sreejesh won the prestigious 'World Games Athlete of the Year' award for his 2021 performances.
- ✓ Indian women's hockey captain Rani Rampal, who won the award in 2020, is the only other Indian to win the honour for her performances in 2019.

Laureus 'World Breakthrough of the Year' Award

- ✓ On February 2, India's champion javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra nominated for the prestigious Laureus 'World Breakthrough of the Year' award.
- Neeraj was the first Indian track and field athlete to win an Olympic gold medal at the Tokyo Olympics on August 8, 2020.

Winter Olympics

- ✓ On February 3, India announced a diplomatic boycott of the Winter Olympics in China, scheduled from February 4-20.
- ✓ The Indian mission in Beijing will not participate in the opening and closing ceremonies of the Games.
- ✓ This followed the decision of China that Qi Fabao, a PLA regiment commander involved in the June 2020 Galwan clash was named as one of the torchbearer during the 'Torch Relay' at the Olympics.

> 2028 Los Angeles Olympics

- ✓ The International Olympic Committee has approved a proposal to include surfing, skateboarding and sport climbing for the 2028 Los Angeles Olympics scheduled for July 21 to August 6, 2028.
- ✓ Breakdancing will debut at the 2024 Olympics at the request of the Paris organisers.

▶ U-19 World Cup

✓ India - won a record-extending fifth U-19 World Cup title after defeating England by four wickets in the final at the Sir Vivian Richards Stadium in North Sound, Antigua on February 5.

Earlier, India had won the U-19 World Cup in 2000, 2008, 2012, and 2018.

> Ireen Wust

- ✓ Ireen Wust became the first athlete to win individual gold at five different Olympic Games.
- ✓ Ireen Wust is already one of the best speed skaters in the history of the sport

✓ Dutchwoman Wust won the 1,500 meters at this edition in Beijing, thereby becoming the first athlete ever to win individual gold medals in five different Olympic Games.

Draft National Air Sports Policy 2022

- ✓ According to Minister of State for Civil Aviation, Gen. Dr. V K Singh, Government has prepared a draft National Air Sports Policy (NASP 2022) for promoting air sports in India.
- ✓ Under the policy, domestic design, development & manufacturing of air sports equipment will be promoted in line with Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan.

OBITUARY

Lata Mangeshkar

- ✓ Legendary singer Lata Mangeshkar passed away on February 6, 2022.
- ✓ She crooned songs in over a thousand Hindi films and has sung in over thirty-six Indian languages.
- ✓ Nicknamed as 'The Nightingale of India', the singer was bestowed with India's highest civilian honor Bharat Ratna in 2001.
- ✓ She was also honored with the Padma Vibhushan and Padma Bhushan.

Luc Montagnier

- ✓ French researcher and virologist Luc Montagnier, who won a noble prize for discovering HIV in 2008 – died on February 8 at the age of 89 years at Neuillysur-Seine, Paris.
- ✓ His involvement in studying about AIDS started in 1982, when the information about a transmissible agent, possibly a virus, was circulated.

Praveen Kumar Sobti

- ✓ Actor-athlete Praveen Kumar Sobti passed away.
- ✓ He was best known for playing Bheem in the TV series "Mahabharat" and for winning an Asian Games gold medal.
- ✓ He won four medals at the Asian Games, including two gold medals in 1966 and 1970.

➤ India's Unemployment Rate

- ✓ India's unemployment rate has fallen to 6.57 percent in January 2022, which is the lowest since March 2021, according to the Centre for Monitoring Indian Economy (CMIE).
- ✓ Unemployment in urban India stood at 8.16 percent in January, while in rural areas it was the lowest at 5.84 percent.

Most Congested Cities in the World 2021

- ✓ Mumbai was ranked as the fifth most congested city in the world 2021, as per TomTom's Traffic Index 2021.
- ✓ Bengaluru was ranked 10th in the index, followed by New Delhi at the 11th place and Pune at the 21st place.
- ✓ Istanbul was ranked as the most congested city in the world, followed by Russia's capital Moscow.

National Crime Records Bureau

- ✓ As per National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) data, the first pandemic year, 2020, witnessed the highest number of suicides among the unemployed in the recent past.
- ✓ The suicide toll has crossed 3,000-mark for the first time. 3548 people died by suicide.

- ✓ Salesforce, a leading company in Customer Relationship Management (CRM), has released the Global Digital Skills Index, 2022.
- ✓ India topped the Salesforce Global Digital Skills Index 2022 with a score of 66 out of 100.
- Brazil and Thailand are on the second spot and third spot with a score of 53 and 48 respectively. The index measures global employee sentiments and readiness to acquire key digital skills.

> EIU's Democracy Index

- ✓ India has ranked 46th position in the 2021 Democracy Index's global ranking, according to The Economist Intelligence Unit.
- ✓ With the highest score of 9.75, Norway topped the Democracy Index 2021 by Economist Intelligence.
- ✓ India scored 6.91 to rank 46th on the list.

US Green Building Council (USGBC)

✓ India ranks 3rd in 9th US Green Building Council.

✓ The US Green Building Council (USGBC) has released the 9th annual ranking of top 10 countries outside of the United States (US) for Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) in 2021 in which India ranked 3rd with 146 projects.
