- ✓ The decision to appoint the head of the interim government of Bangladesh was taken during a meeting between President Shahabuddin and the coordinators of the anti-discrimination student movement.
- ✓ Earlier, a 13-member team of the Anti-Discrimination Student Movement visited Bangabhaban to discuss the current situation in Bangladesh and the outline of the interim government.

- ✓ Harris who became the first Indian-American to win the nomination from a major political party.
- ✓ Harris's nomination became official after a five-day round of online balloting by Democratic National Convention delegates.

Vinesh Phogat Disqualified In Paris Olympic 2024



- ✓ Indian wrestler Vinesh Phogat has been disqualified from the Paris Olympics after failing to meet weight requirement for her 50 kg gold medal.
- ✓ As per the report, Phogat was reportedly over the permissible weight limit by just 100 grams, which may lead to her disqualification.
- ✓ According to competition rules, she will not be eligible for a silver medal, leaving only gold and bronze winners in the 50 kg category.

IMPORTANT DAYS

National Javelin Day - August 07



- ✓ On August 7, 2021, Neeraj Chopra etched his name in history by winning India's first-ever Olympic gold medal in track and field.
- ✓ His historic javelin throw of 87.58 metres not only secured the gold but also made him the second Indian to win an individual Olympic gold, following Abhinav Bindra.
