- India to Roll out new treatment regimen for drug-resistant TB
- India is getting ready to roll out the BPaL (bedaquiline, pretomanid, and linezolid) regimen for all multidrug resistant tuberculosis (MDR-TB) and extensively drugresistant tuberculosis (XDR-TB) patients.
- ✓ The training for this new exercise is scheduled to begin this month.
- ✓ This is a significant move in the country's battle against M/XDR-TB.

- > Women outnumbered men in living organ donations last year
- Women led the way in living organ donation, offering patients suffering from endstage organ failure a new lease of life.



- ✓ Data released by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare show that the number of women living donors was 9,784 last year compared to 5,651 men.
- ✓ A lone transgender contributed an organ to save the life of another human being, taking the total number of living donors in the country in 2023 to 15,436.
