- > WHO Declares Mpox a Global Public Health Emergency
- The World Health Organization (WHO) declared mpox a "public health emergency of international concern" (PHEIC), on August 14, 2024.



- This decision was made after experts noticed a rise in mpox cases, especially in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and other African countries.
- Mpox, formerly called monkeypox, is a viral disease mostly found in Central and West Africa.
- ✓ It was first discovered in monkeys in 1958 but mainly spreads through rodents.
