



EVERYDAY CURRENT AFFAIRS – JUNE 29, 2026

INTERNATIONAL

Teesta Project

- The Teesta River Comprehensive Management and Restoration Project is a major infrastructure project in Bangladesh.
- It focuses on river dredging, embankment construction, land reclamation, and road development.
- The project aims to improve water management, flood control, irrigation, and regional connectivity.
- Planned works include dredging 140 million cubic metres of sediment.
- It also proposes construction and repair of over 230 km of embankments.
- The project gained attention after discussions between Bangladesh and China during Prime Minister Tarique Rahman's visit to Beijing.
- China has offered technical assistance and clarified that the project is not directed against any third country.
- The Teesta River flows through Sikkim, West Bengal, and Bangladesh, making it strategically significant.
- The initiative has implications for India-Bangladesh water sharing, regional connectivity, and geopolitical cooperation.

NATIONAL

PM Family Care Tracker

- Gujarat launched the PM Family Care Tracker (PM-FCT) and Health Passport on 28 June 2026.

- It is a pilot digital platform for maternal and child welfare.
- The system tracks beneficiaries from pregnancy until 16–18 years of age.
- It integrates health, education, nutrition, birth registration, and welfare databases.
- Officials receive alerts for missed vaccinations and school dropouts.
- The platform ensures timely delivery of government welfare schemes.
- Multiple departments are connected through a unified digital system.
- It supports Viksit Gujarat @2047 and Viksit Bharat @2047.
- The initiative strengthens digital governance and public service delivery.

Anaemia Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan

- The Union Health Ministry released revised Anaemia Mukht Bharat guidelines on 29 June 2026.
- The programme introduces the new 7x7x7 Strategy.
- It covers 7 beneficiary groups, 7 interventions, and 7 institutional mechanisms.
- Low birth weight infants have been added as a new beneficiary group.
- The programme shifts from the T3 model to T4 (Test, Treat, Talk, Track).
- “Eating Right” has been included to promote iron-rich diets.
- Digital integration has been strengthened through JANANI, RBSK, and U-WIN.
- The guidelines focus on prevention, treatment, nutrition, and monitoring.
- The initiative aims to reduce anaemia among women, children, and adolescents.

e-Sushrut@Clinic

- The Union Health Ministry launched e-Sushrut@Clinic on 29 June 2026.
- It is a cloud-based Hospital Management Information System (HMIS).
- The platform was developed by C-DAC.
- It is designed for small clinics, PHCs, Health & Wellness Centres, and sub-centres.
- The system digitises patient registration, billing, and medical records.
- It also provides speech-to-text documentation and clinical decision support.
- The National Health Authority supports implementation through an MoU with C-DAC.
- The platform integrates with the Health Professional Registry (HPR) and Health Facility Registry (HFR).
- More than 800 healthcare facilities have already adopted the system.

STATE

West Bengal Uniform Civil Code Bill

- The West Bengal Uniform Civil Code (UCC) Bill is expected to be introduced during the State Assembly Budget Session on 29 June 2026.
- The proposed law seeks to establish a common civil code for all citizens irrespective of religion.
- It is based on Article 44 of the Directive Principles of State Policy.
- The Bill covers matters related to marriage, divorce, adoption, guardianship, succession, and inheritance.
- It proposes equal inheritance rights for all citizens.
- The draft includes a ban on polygamy and declares child marriages invalid.
- It also proposes mandatory registration of live-in relationships.
- Supporters believe the Bill promotes gender justice, legal equality, and simplified civil laws.
- Critics argue that broad consultation is necessary to protect religious freedom, cultural diversity, and federal principles.

DEFENSE

Indian Army to Raise First Integrated Battle Groups

- The Indian Army will operationalise its first Integrated Battle Groups (IBGs) on 1 July 2026.
- The new formations will be raised under the Panagarh-based XVII Corps (Mountain Strike Corps).
- Each IBG is a brigade-sized, self-sufficient combat formation with more than 5,000 troops.
- The groups integrate infantry, artillery, armour, engineers, logistics, signals, air defence, and medical units.
- IBGs are designed for rapid deployment within 48 hours during emergencies.
- The reform aims to improve operational flexibility and battlefield coordination.
- The concept was proposed by General Bipin Rawat, India's first Chief of Defence Staff (CDS).
- Initial implementation includes four IBGs and one Fire Support Group under the XVII Corps.
- The initiative will strengthen India's preparedness for multi-domain warfare, particularly along the India-China border.

SPORTS

Who Is Ancy Sojan? Kerala Long Jumper Who Broke Anju Bobby George's 22-Year-Old National Record

- Ancy Sojan created history at the 2026 National Inter-State Senior Athletics Championships.
- The championship was held in Bhubaneswar, Odisha.
- She recorded a jump of 6.88 metres in the women's long jump event.
- The mark broke Anju Bobby George's national record of 6.83 metres, set in 2004.
- Ancy represents Kerala in national competitions.
- She also serves as a Chief Petty Officer in the Indian Navy.
- The record-breaking jump came on her fifth attempt during the final.
- She won the gold medal and qualified for the 2026 Asian Games.
- Ancy has also won medals at the Asian Games, Asian Athletics Championships, and Asian Indoor Championships.

Indonesia Wins Maiden AVC Men's Volleyball Cup 2026 Title as India Secures Historic Bronze

- Indonesia won its first-ever AVC Men's Volleyball Cup title in 2026.
- The tournament was hosted in Ahmedabad, Gujarat.
- Indonesia defeated Korea 3-0 in the final.
- The team had earlier lost to Korea during the group stage.
- Indonesia reached the final after defeating Qatar, Thailand, Oman, and India.
- Boy Arnez Arabi scored 17 points in the final.
- He was named the tournament's Most Valuable Player (MVP).
- India defeated defending champions Bahrain to win its first-ever AVC Cup bronze medal.
- Indonesia also improved its position in the FIVB World Rankings from 52nd to 43rd.

IMPORTANT DAYS

Statistics Day 2026

- Statistics Day is observed every year in India on 29 June.
- The day commemorates the birth anniversary of Prof. Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis.

- Mahalanobis is widely regarded as the Father of Modern Indian Statistics.
- The 2026 theme is “Unlocking the Potential of Administrative Data.”
- The event is organized by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI).
- The National Statistical Office (NSO) also plays a key role in the celebrations.
- The theme highlights the importance of government-generated data for policymaking and governance.
- Reports related to SDGs, labour statistics, and data harmonisation were released during the event.
- The Sukhatme National Award in Statistics was presented to recognize excellence in the field.
